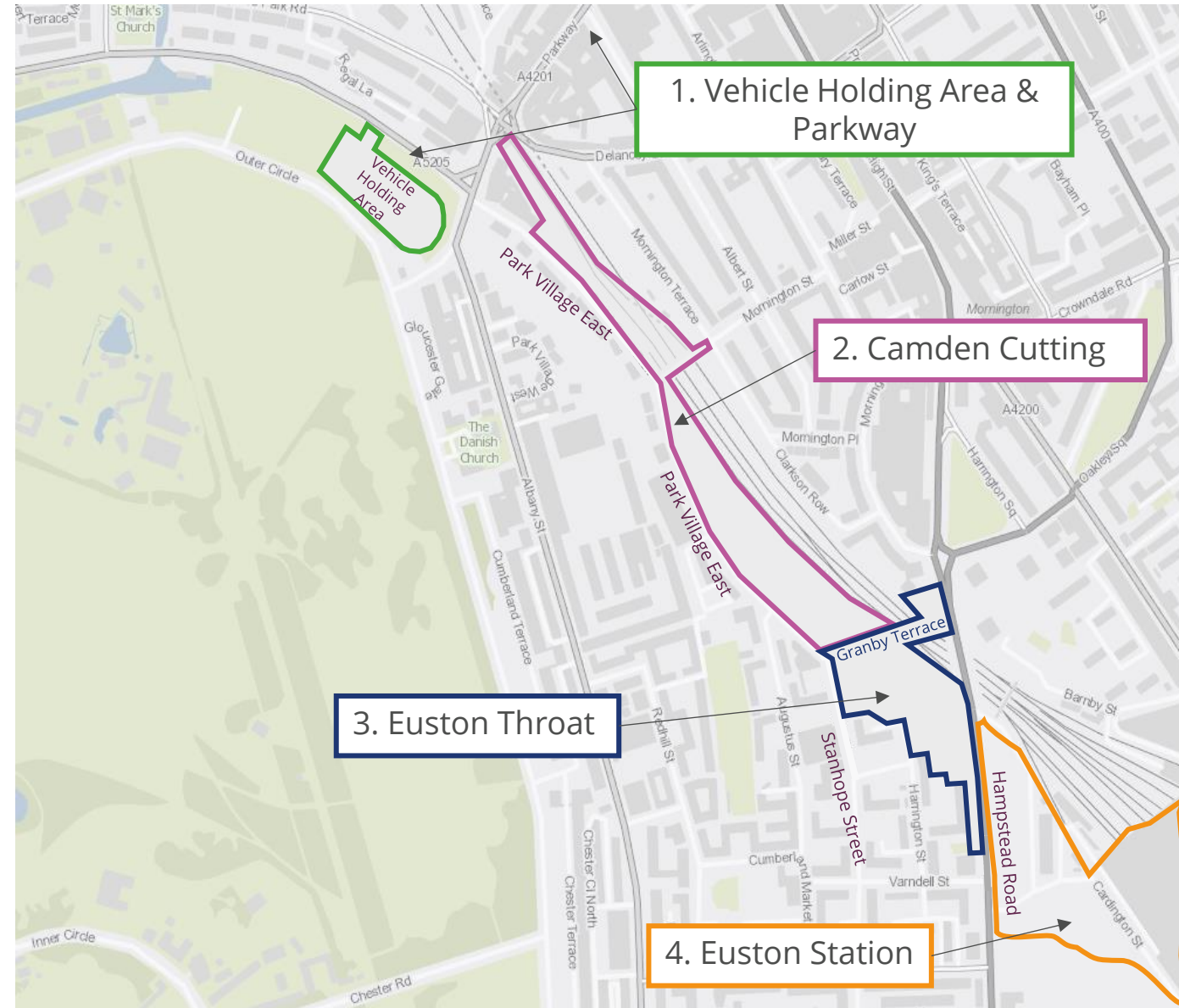

Vehicle Holding Area/ Parkway (SCS)



Parkway utility works – February to October 2026

We need to protect and divert utility services beneath Parkway junction and in the surrounding area before the tunnelling boring machine passes beneath. In February we started our utility works on the sewers, water mains and power cables on Parkway, Albert Street and Delancey Street. We expect to complete these works in October 2026.

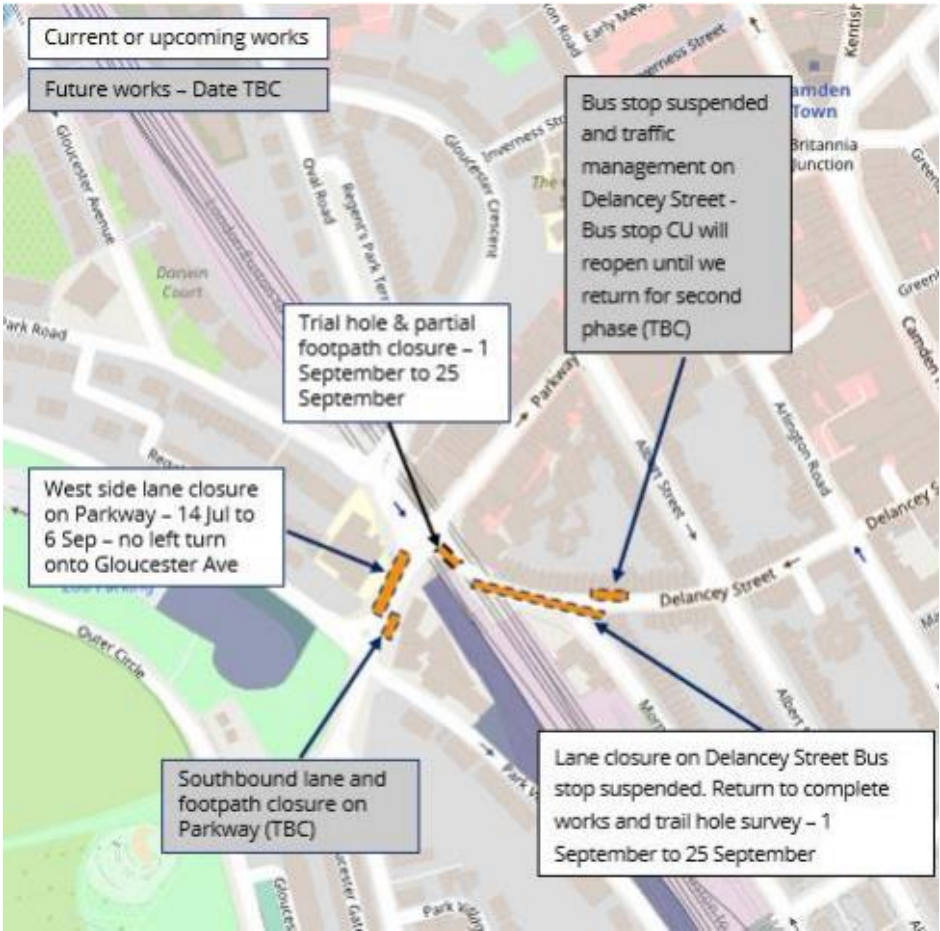
In autumn 2026, we'll return to Parkway to complete protective works to the Cadent Gas main.

Reinstatement of white lining at the Vehicle Holding Area – 29 August 2026

We need to reinstate the white lining at the entrance to our Vehicle Holding Area (VHA) to ensure safety for our vehicle movements when entering and leaving site. We'll need to remove the old lining by using a high-powered water blaster before applying the new lining.

We'll work on Saturday 29 August, from 8am to 5pm to complete this work. If we cannot complete this work on 29 August, we may need to work the following Saturday as contingency.

Mornington Street bridge reopened

We reopened Mornington Street bridge to vehicles on 8 January 2024. We have put a 3-tonne weight limit in place which we are managing with width restriction barriers at both end of the bridge.

For safety reasons, Network Rail and SCS will continue to monitor the bridge whilst work continues beneath it.

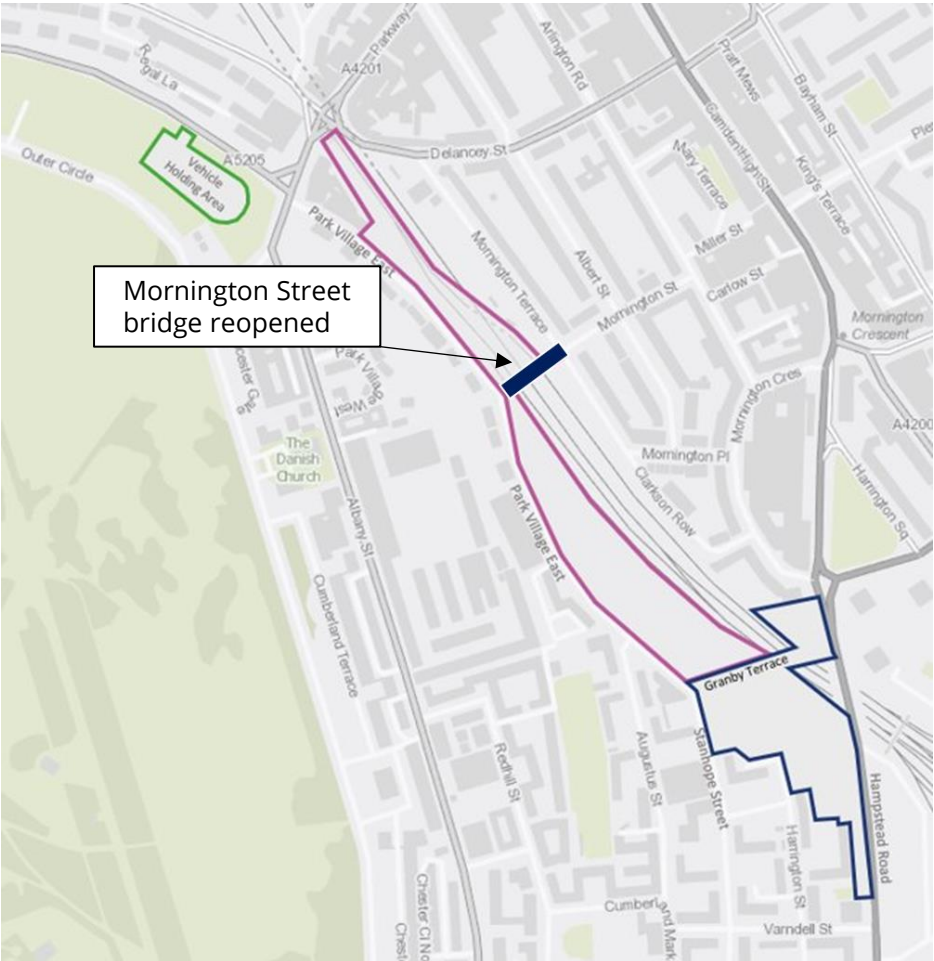
Please note the bridge will be closed throughout the duration of tunnelling works and we will update you in advance. These are expected to take 5 years to complete.

Traffic impact

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Replacement of hoarding graphics on Park Village East

We are replacing the hoarding graphics at the southern end of Park Village East, as it has been damaged by the weather over time.

We began replacing the hoarding in sections starting from Mornington Street bridge. Unfortunately, due to unexpected delays, we have paused these works and will continue from 24 August. We'll work from 8am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday. We expect to complete these works by 15 September.

Traffic impact

- Temporary footpath closures and intermittent parking bay suspensions from Sunday before each week
- Pedestrian diversion around footpath closure

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Mornington Street bridge temporary closure

From 14 September we'll close Mornington Street bridge to vehicles. We'll install new kerbs and road markings to manage the 3-tonne weight limit in place on the bridge. The new kerbs will replace the temporary width restriction barriers we currently have in place. We'll work Monday to Friday, 8am to 6pm. We expect to complete these works by 18 September.

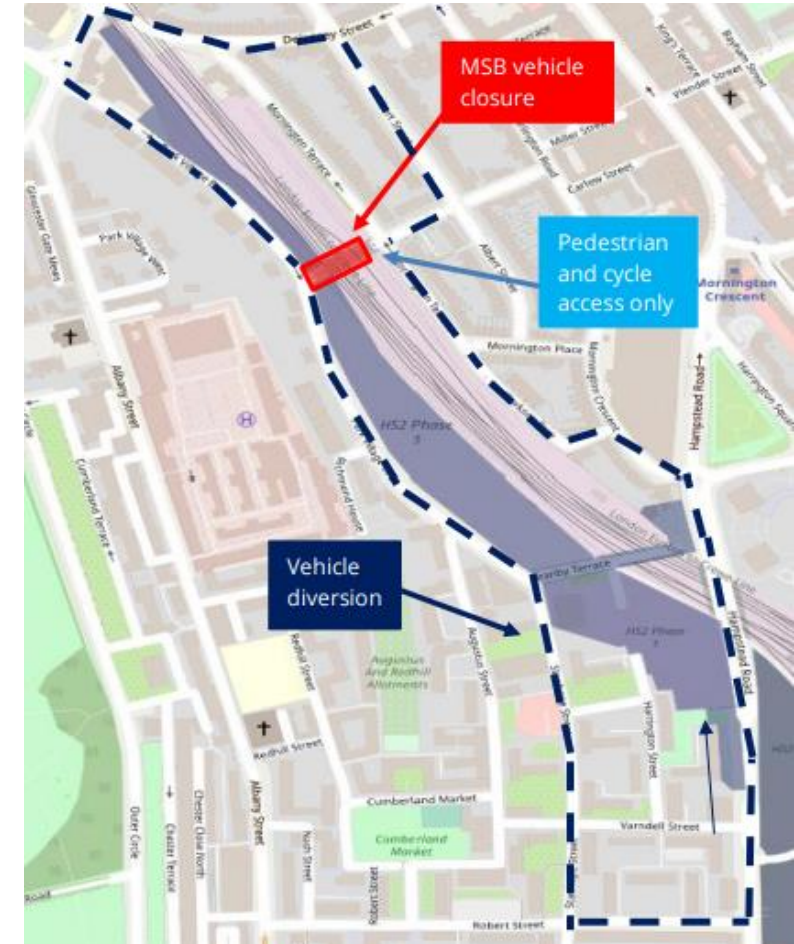
Please note the bridge will remain closed for the duration of these works.

Traffic impact

- Temporary traffic diversions via Mornington Street, Albert Street, Delancey Street, Parkway, Park Village East, Stanhope Street, Robert Street, Hampstead Road, Mornington Crescent and Clarkson Row
- Access maintained for cyclists and pedestrians

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Euston Throat (SCS)



Southbound cycle lane and footpath closure on Hampstead Road, south of Cardington Street – 4 May onwards

In preparation for Mace Dragados' (MDjv) Western Utility Road programme, which will run parallel to Hampstead Road (within site), we need to construct some British Telecommunications (BT) chambers in the southbound cycle lane and footpath. We started these works on 4 May and will continue until October 2026.

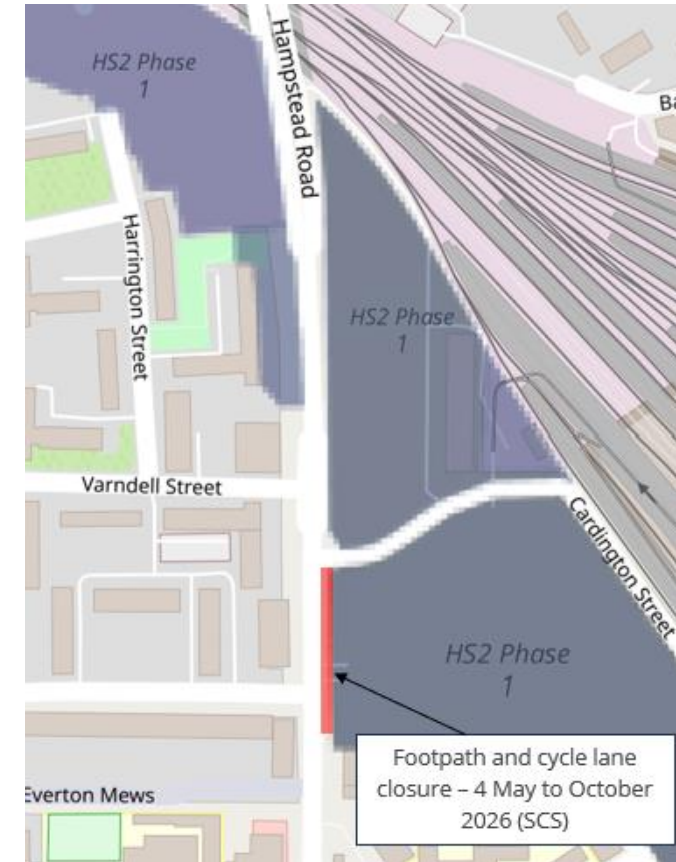
Duration of works: 4 May until October 2026

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Lane closures on Hampstead Road – 13 August to 4 September

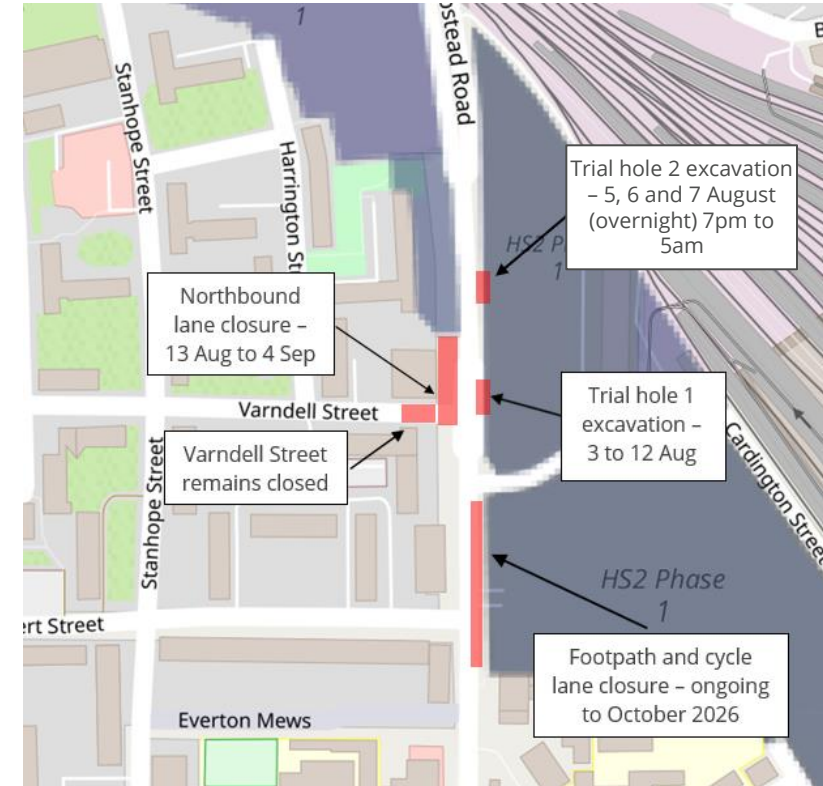
We are continuing our utility diversion works in the southern section of Hampstead Road in preparation for the Hampstead Road bridge extension works. From 13 August, we'll close the northbound lane on Hampstead Road north of Varndell Street, which will remain closed. Vehicle access to Regent's Park Estate will be via Robert Street. We expect to complete these works by 4 September. Our traffic management will be set out overnight on the 13 August.

Traffic impacts:

- Northbound lane on Hampstead Road
- Vehicle access to Regent's Park Estate via Robert Street

North Gower Street and Euston Street Utility Diversions – April to October 2026

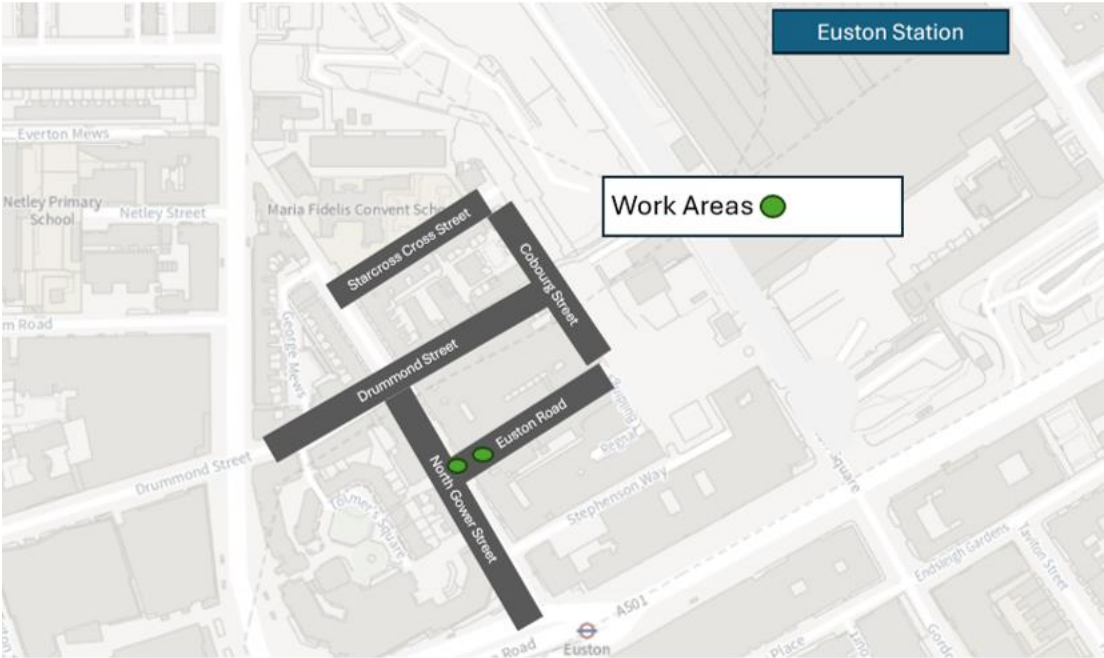
We are carrying out utility diversions on North Gower Street and Euston Street.

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Eversholt Street utility diversions – ongoing until 2028

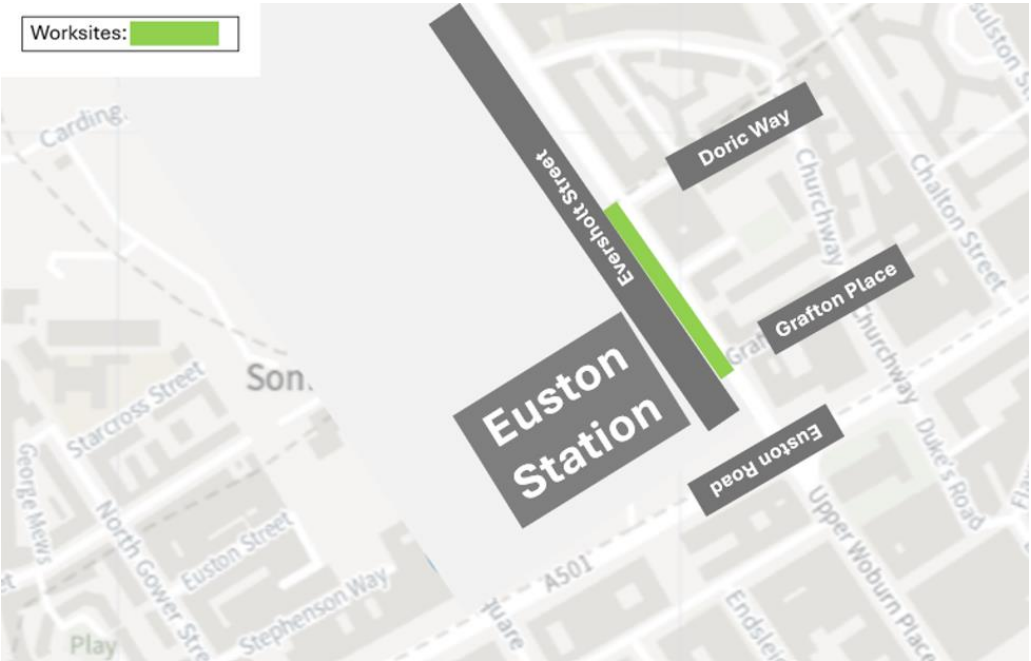
We are carrying out utility diversions on Eversholt Street.
