What are we doing?

As we move to the next phase of construction of the Small Dean Viaduct, there will be lane closures in May for abnormal load deliveries to the A413 piers site. These deliveries will be for precast hammerhead units.

To carry out these deliveries safely, the lane closures will be under a 2-way temporary traffic light system. This is for safety reasons as our operatives will be working in and around the carriage way.

To reduce impact on road users, these traffic lights will be in operation at off-peak times.

When will these works take place?

These works are scheduled for the **daytime (off-peak) between 8:30am - 5pm** on the following dates:

- Friday 3 May
- Sunday 5 May

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but works will be completed in or around the set timeframes.



Where is the phase 1 re-alignment?


Below is the animated example of the diversion of the A413. You can see the original road and the piers to the left and the new temporary surface to the right.
