What are we doing?

As part of our preparations for the construction of the River Itchen Viaduct, we will be reinforcing the river bank using a support method called sheet piling.

An example, similar to the work we are completing, is shown in the picture below.



Sheet piling involves driving interlocking metal sheets into the ground, to create a strong retaining wall between the viaduct and the waterside.

An increase in noise may be experienced while part of this work is carried out.

The work has been approved by the local authority.

When will these works take place?

From Tuesday 28 May to Friday 28 June 2024.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as poor weather.

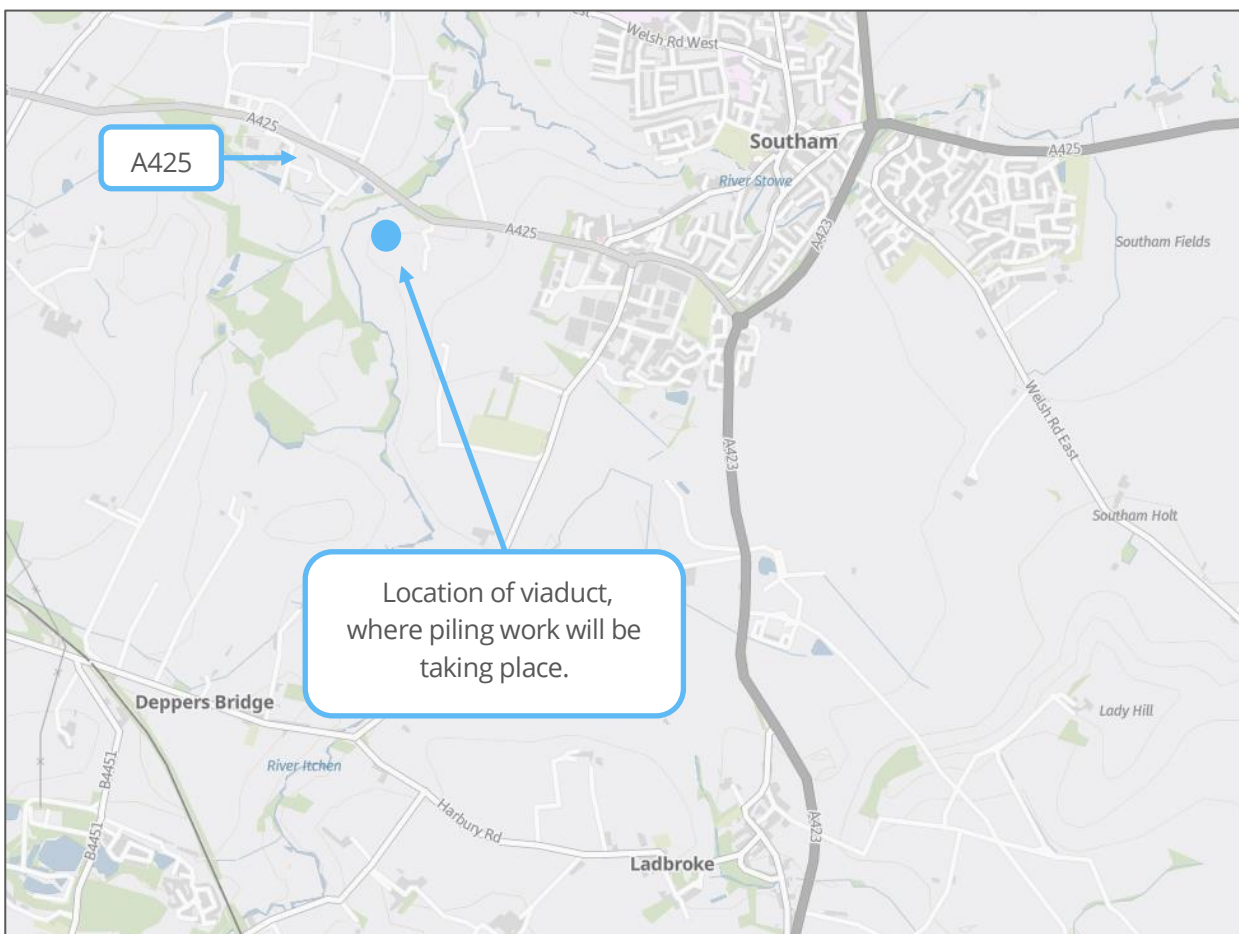
