



## Notice of Road Closure, Nash Lee Road for bridge inspection

### What are we doing?

Last summer, we introduced a temporary realignment of Nash Lee Road for public use. The new road incorporates a temporary bridge carrying road traffic. At the end of May, we will perform an inspection and general maintenance work on the bridge to ensure continued safe operation of the structure.

To carry out these maintenance works we will be closing the road overnight for three nights. This ensures the safety of road users whilst the bridge is being inspected, and the safety of our operatives who will be working in and around the carriageway.

We are doing the works overnight to reduce the impact of this closure on road users. Future maintenance works will be conducted periodically while the bridge is in operation.

### When will these works take place?

Overnight road closure (8.30pm – 5.30am):

- **Tuesday 28 May to Friday 31 May**

These dates are subject to change due to circumstances beyond our control. Should we finish the works early, the traffic management will be withdrawn.

Overnight road closures (8:30pm – 5:30am) will operate from:

Tuesday 28 May to Friday 31 May 2024

Operatives working over the entire area of the Nash Lee bridge.

Road closure on Nash Lee Road with a fully signposted diversion route in operation.

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

## Where will the lane closure be?

The road closure will operate in the location on the map below. The closures will be introduced overnight and will operate between 8:30pm and 5:30am from the evening of Tuesday 28 May to the early hours of Friday 31 May. During the closure, a fully signposted diversion route through Stoke Mandeville will be in operation.
