High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. BBVS is the contractor working on behalf of HS2 to construct the Old Oak Common station.

# What are we doing

We recently contacted you regarding vegetation clearance and tree felling, which is taking place between May and June 2024: **Advanced** Notice Letter; HS2-MW-BBVS-Ph1-OOC-St-S4-CR-31-24/02/2024 delivered on 13 May 2024.


Phase 1 of works has started, with the initial bat surveys taking place in May 2024. We have further bat surveys to be completed before the planned tree felling, which begins between 1am Sunday 9 June and 3am Monday 10 June 2024

Vegetation clearance will start in both locations identified on the map below in early June 2024. All appropriate guidance will be followed, with ecologists on site during the work.
