High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

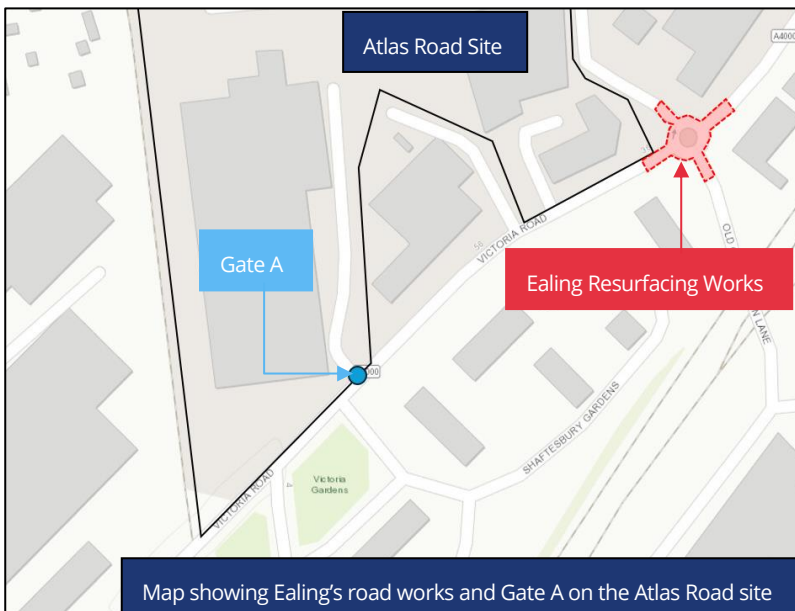
HS2 lorry gate change during Ealing Road works

On **Sunday the 30 June and Sunday 7 July**, Ealing Council's Highways team will be carrying out works on the Victoria Road/Atlas Road roundabout.

These works will take place from 8am to 4pm on each day and consist of various closures around the roundabout whilst they resurface the road. A notification has been sent by Ealing with additional details regarding these works.

During these works HS2 lorries entering and exiting the Atlas Road site will need to use Gate A (see image below) as access to Gates B and C on Atlas Road will not be available.

We will use traffic marshals to assist the movement of any vehicles entering Gate A to help minimise any disruption to the community.
