What are we doing?

To enable the next phase of construction of the Small Dean Viaduct we will be undertaking a second realignment of the A413 London Road. The new alignment will enable us to complete construction of the final piers for the Small Dean Viaduct.

The phases of works are as follows:

- Daytime off-peak lane closures
- Overnight full road closure to install kerb tie-ins, surfacing and tarmacking

When will these works take place?

Daytime lane closures with traffic lights:

- Monday 1 to Friday 26 July (weekdays only)

2 August update:

- Friday 9 August – Sunday 11 August
- Thursday 22 August

Overnight full road closure:

- Monday 22 July to Thursday 25 July
- Monday 29 July to Friday 2 August
- Monday 5 to Friday 9 August
- Monday 12 to Thursday 15 August

To minimise disruption, we will introduce a fully signposted diversion route and have chosen to work overnight to reduce our road impact.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control.

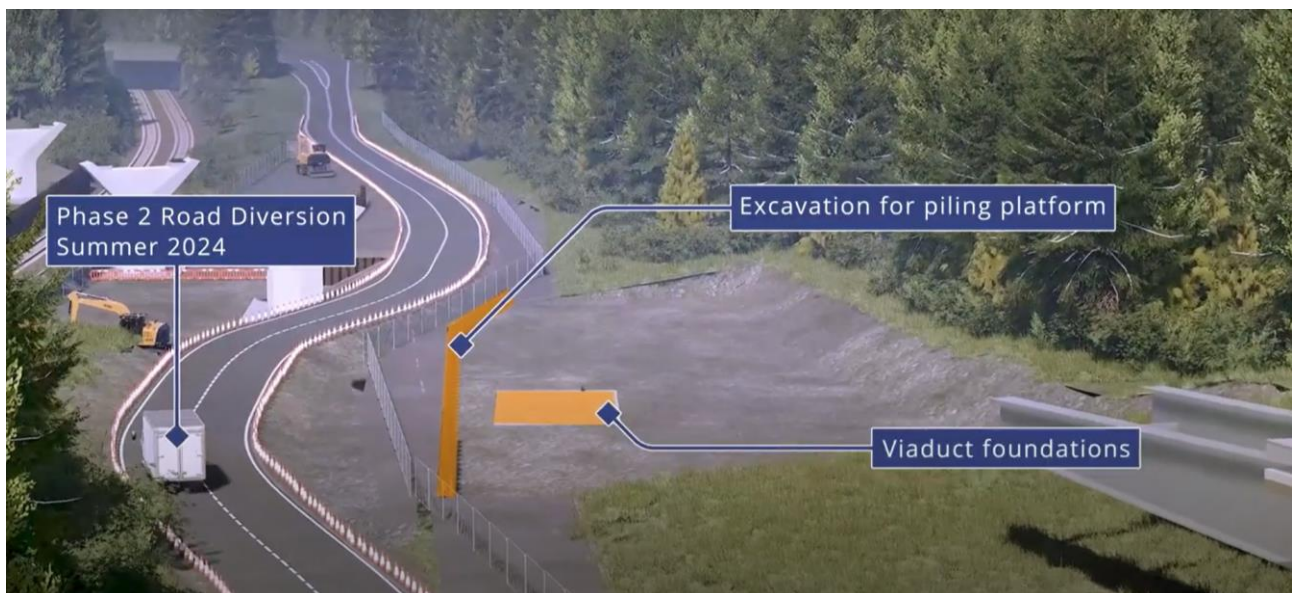


Small Dean Viaduct construction phases video

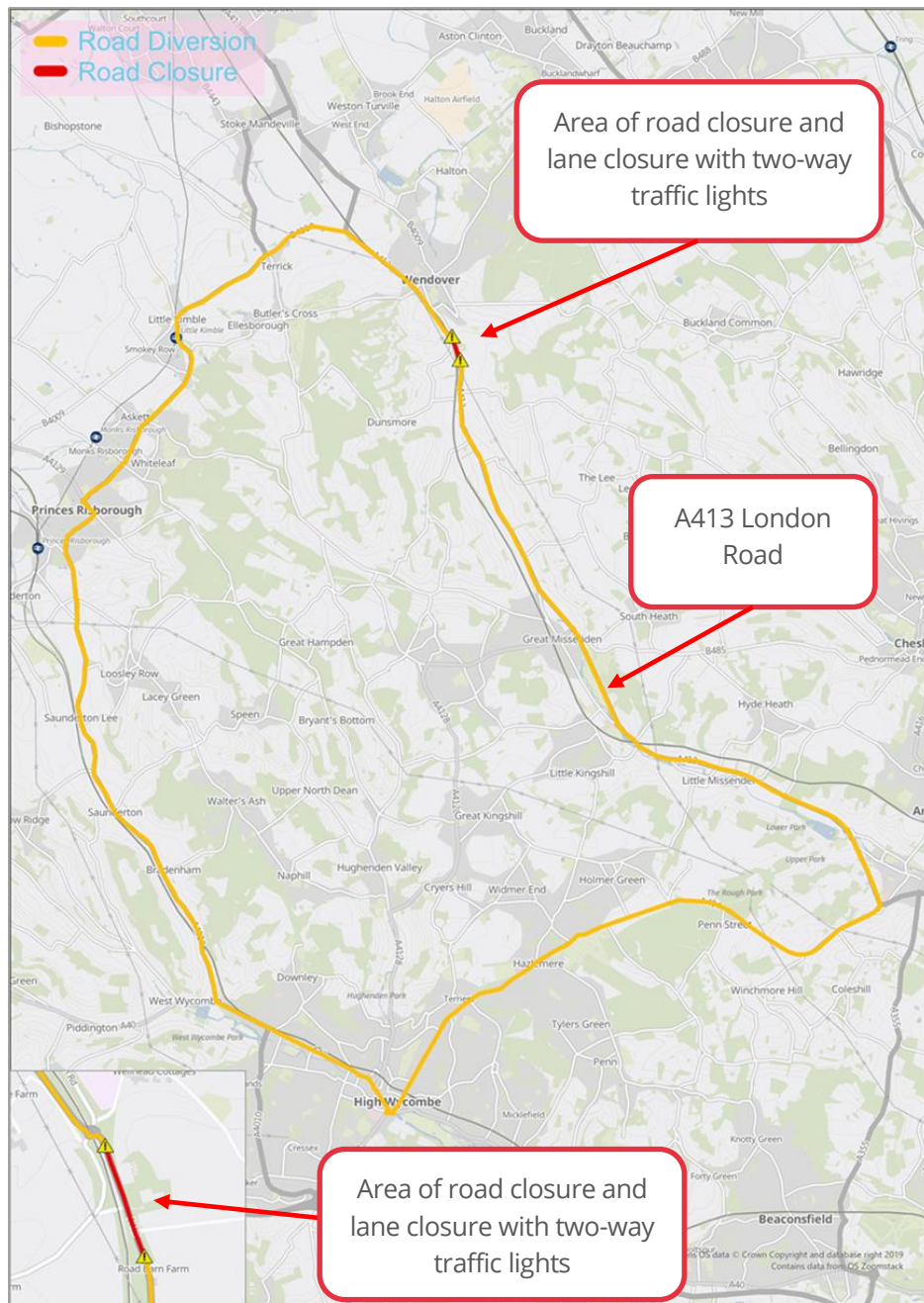

Where will the closures be?

The map below, shows the area of road where there will be an off-peak daytime lane closure on the A413 overnight with two-way traffic lights throughout July and some dates in August.

The map below also shows the area for the overnight road closure from Monday 22 July to Friday 26 July with three further closures through August. During closure periods a fully signposted diversion route will be in operation.
