What are we doing?

In July, we will be carrying out verge maintenance and intermittent grass cutting on Rocky Lane.

These works will take place between 8:30am and 5:30pm. Due to the existing traffic management in the area and to protect the safety of our team working close to the carriageway, the road will be closed for the duration of our works. We will have a diversion route in place for the closure, which can be found on the following page.

Resident access will be maintained throughout the closure. However, residents who live in the east side of Rocky Lane near the intersection with Chesham Lane will need to use the diversion to access their properties.

When will these works take place?

- **Tuesday 9 July 2024 (8:30am – 5:30pm)**

To minimise disruption, we will introduce a fully signposted diversion route, please refer to the map on the following page.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but works will be completed in or around the set timeframes.

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

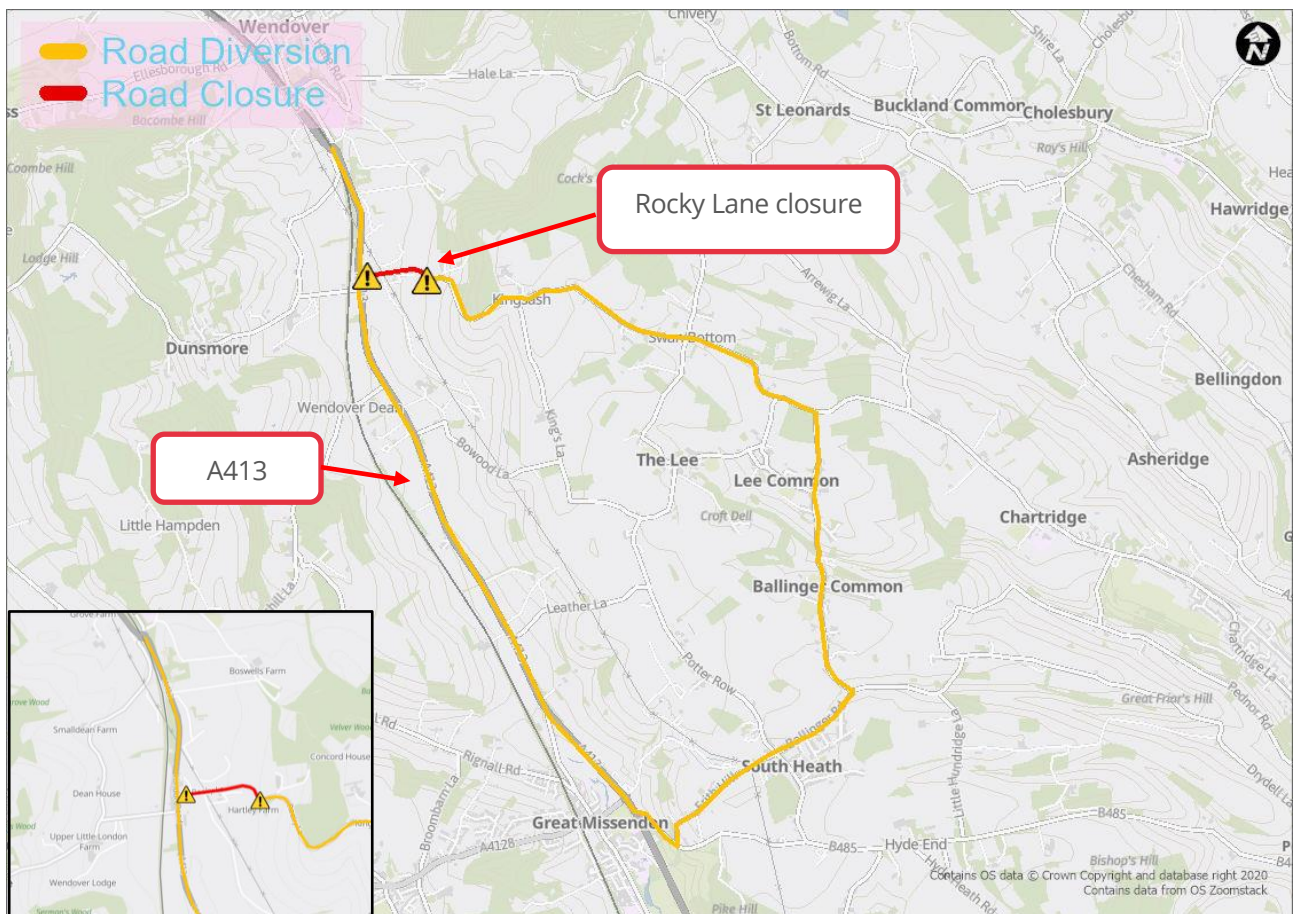
