What are we doing?

On Friday 21 June 2024 there will be an overnight closure on the crossroads of Station Road South, Quainton Road and Station Road North to install temporary traffic management at the crossroads. The closure will be between the hours of 8.30pm until 5.30am.

An overnight closure is required as the temporary traffic management needs to be connected to the mains as opposed to being battery operated, ensuring continuous efficiency of the traffic lights.

These traffic lights are to facilitate the upcoming works on Quainton Road which are due to commence on 24 June 2024.

When will these works take place?

There will be an overnight closure at the crossroads of Station Road South, Quainton Road and Station Road North from Friday 21 June until Saturday 22 June between 8.30pm until 5.30am.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

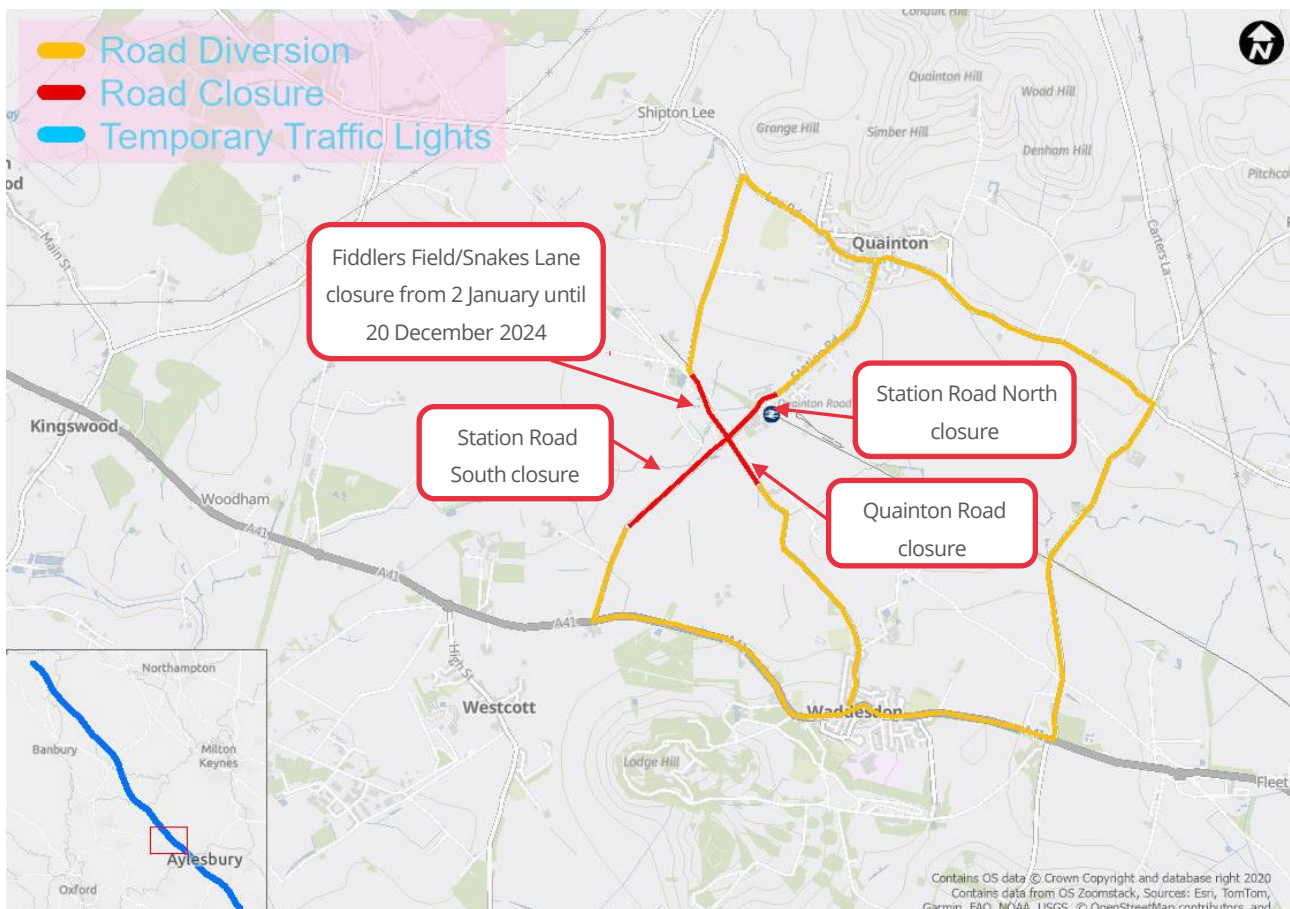
