

Installation of monitoring equipment

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What we are doing

From 24 October 2024 we plan to install monitoring equipment on two retaining walls at SELCO and Manhattan Business Park.

The equipment is designed to detect any movement which may occur during construction works in your local area. The monitoring equipment is installed as a precaution. We do not anticipate a large amount of movement.

The monitoring prisms will be fixed to the exterior walls by drilling into the brickwork or sticking to the metal support beams. We will assess installation method in each location and may use an alternative method to attach it, such as glue.

We will contact each property owners ahead of installation.

Once installed, survey teams will undertake regular surveys from Westgate and the car park of Chelsea House. We may also need to do maintenance visits to ensure the equipment is clean.

The images below show examples of the monitoring equipment we will install on the exterior of properties in your area.



The monitoring equipment will be removed when our works are completed in your local area. Following its removal, we will carry out repairs to make good the area where the monitoring equipment was located.
