Delivering HS2 London Tunnels

Skanska Costain STRABAG Joint Venture (SCSJV) are working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build 16.4 miles (26.4 kilometres) of the high-speed railway between Euston and West Ruislip.

This includes 13 miles (21 kilometres) of tunnels and the associated ventilation (vent) shafts and headhouses to provide access to the tunnels for maintenance and emergency services, ventilation and power supply.



Works on A40 Western Avenue

What we are doing

We will be carrying out works to protect the mains gas pipe below the A40 Western Avenue between Alperton Lane and Hanger Lane Gyratory prior to building the HS2 London Tunnels.

During these works, there will be phased traffic management in place on the A40 Western Avenue including:

- Lane closures
- Contraflow system to maintain traffic flow
- Diversion over Hanger Lane Gyratory due to A40 tunnel closure
- Overnight lane closure on 20, 21 and 22 May to install cameras
- There may be overnight closures during changes to phasing please refer to notification


Indicative construction programme

Construction Activity	Date
Removal of central reservation and installation of contraflow system	27 May to 7 July 2024*
Contraflow system in operation and gas upgrade works commence	8 July to 6 October2024*
Removal of contraflow system and reinstatement of central reservation	6 October to 24 October 2024*

Works on the A40 Western Avenue

The main gas pipe crosses the A40 from Lynwood Road towards West Gate. The excavation area will progress from south to north as the current main is replaced. The excavation in the first section should take around three weeks, and the remaining sections should take around two weeks each.

Phase one - 27 May to 11 July 2024*

What will we be doing?


We will be working overnight to build two crossover sections for a contraflow system to be used during the upgrade of the main gas pipe. This includes removing the central reservation on two sections of the A40 Western Avenue.

How might this affect you?

Between 6am and 10pm* we will close lane three on both the East and Westbound Carriageways.

Between 10pm to 6am* we will close lane two and three on both the East and Westbound Carriageway.

The Hanger Lane Gyratory tunnels will also be closed, and traffic will be diverted around Hanger Lane Gyratory.

Phase one – 27 May to 11 July 2024*

How might this affect you?

The Eastbound and Westbound tunnels under Hanger Lane Gyratory will be closed overnight while we work on the central reservation, and traffic will be diverted around the Gyratory.

Diversion signs and information will be clearly visible.


Phase two - 12 July to 28 July 2024*

What will we be doing?

We will be carrying out works to protect the mains gas pipe below the A40 Western Avenue between Alperton Lane and Hanger Lane Gyratory before building the HS2 London Tunnels.

How might this affect you?


We will have traffic management in place 24-hours a day. On the Westbound Carriageway, lanes one and two will be closed, while lane three will be used for traffic travelling Westbound. On the Eastbound carriageway, lane three will be used for traffic travelling Westbound, and lane one and two will be for traffic travelling Eastbound.

Phase three - 28 July to 12 August 2024*


What will we be doing?

We will be carrying out works to protect the mains gas pipe below the A40 Western Avenue between Alperton Lane and Hanger Lane Gyratory before building the HS2 London Tunnels.

How might this affect you?

We will have traffic management in place 24-hours a day. On the Westbound Carriageway, lanes two and three will be closed, while lane one will be used for traffic travelling Westbound. On the Eastbound carriageway, lane three will be used for traffic travelling Westbound, while lanes one and two will be for traffic travelling Eastbound.

Once drivers enter one of the Westbound lanes, they will have to follow it through to the end of the works area, after which they will be able to switch between lanes again.


Phase four - 12 August to 28 August 2024*

What will we be doing?

We will be carrying out works to protect the mains gas pipe below the A40 Western Avenue between Alperton Lane and Hanger Lane Gyratory prior to construction of the HS2 London Tunnels.

How might this affect you?

We will have traffic management in place 24-hours a day. On the Westbound Carriageway, lane three will be closed, while lanes one and two will be used for traffic travelling Westbound. On the Eastbound carriageway, lane three will be closed, while lanes one and two will be used for traffic travelling Eastbound.

Phase five - 28 August to 10 September 2024*

What will we be doing?

We will be carrying out works to protect the mains gas pipe below the A40 Western Avenue between Alperton Lane and Hanger Lane Gyratory prior to construction of the HS2 London Tunnels.


How might this affect you?

We will have traffic management in place 24-hours a day. On the Westbound Carriageway, lanes one and two will be used for traffic travelling Westbound, while lane three will be used for traffic travelling Eastbound. On the Eastbound carriageway, lanes two and three will be closed, while lane one will be used for traffic travelling Eastbound.

Drivers who wish to access the A406 from Hanger Lane Gyratory should use lane one Eastbound.

Drivers travelling into Central London should use the contraflow lane for Eastbound traffic.

Once drivers enter one of the Eastbound lanes, they will have to follow it through to the end of the works area, after which they will be able to switch between lanes again.

Phase six - 10 September to 8 October 2024*

What will we be doing?

We will be carrying out works to protect the mains gas pipe below the A40 Western Avenue between Alperton Lane and Hanger Lane Gyratory prior to construction of the HS2 London Tunnels.


How might this affect you?

We will have traffic management in place 24-hours a day. On the Westbound Carriageway, lanes one and two will be used for traffic travelling Westbound, while lane three will be used for traffic travelling Eastbound. On the Eastbound carriageway, lane three will be used for traffic travelling Eastbound, while lanes one will be closed.

Drivers who wish to access the A406 from Hanger Lane Gyratory should use lane three Eastbound.

Drivers travelling into Central London should use the contraflow lane for Eastbound traffic.

Once drivers enter one of the Eastbound lanes, they will have to follow it through to the end of the works area, after which they will be able to switch between lanes again.

Phase seven - 8 October to 24 October 2024*


What will we be doing?

We will be carrying out works to remove the two crossover sections and contraflow system which were used during the main works. This includes the reconstruction of the central reservation on the A40 Western Avenue.

How might this affect you?

During the day, we will have traffic management in place which will be a closure of lane three on both the East and Westbound Carriageway between the hours of 6am to 10pm*.

Overnight, we will have traffic management in place which will be a closure of lane two and three on both the East and Westbound Carriageway between the hours of 10pm to 6am*.

Phase seven - 6 October to 24 October 2024*

How might this affect you?

The Eastbound and Westbound tunnels under Hanger Lane Gyratory will be closed overnight while we work on the central reservation, and traffic will be diverted around the Gyratory.

Diversion signs and information will be clearly visible.

Measures to minimise disruption

Noise and Vibration

Noise levels are expected to be highest during excavation which will be taking place:

- Overnight during the removal and reinstatement of the central reservation
- During the day throughout the gas upgrade works

Noise will be managed through:

- Selective plant & equipment
- Acoustic blankets
- Equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Monitoring logs will be kept

Once excavation is complete, noise will be significantly reduced and is not expected to be louder than usual background levels.

Lighting


- All lighting will be low level and within the site focusing away from residential areas
- Lighting will be turned off when staff are not on site

Dust

- Damping down / screening
- Daily dust logs
- Stockpiles will be sheeted, and kept away from local receptors
- Vehicles entering / leaving site will not be overloaded
