High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Utility Works on 'lower' Kilburn High Road

We recently wrote to you about the ongoing works on Oxford Road and Greville Road, which we expected to have completed by 13 December 2024. Due to a delay in the arrival of some materials necessary for road reinstatement, the works on Greville Road and Oxford Road have now been **extended to 20**December 2024.

We recognise the impact that the works and delays have caused and apologise for the disruption. Updates will be provided at HS2 in Camden - HS2. Thank you for your patience and understanding throughout these works.
