High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing.

As part of the ongoing construction to complete the new overbridge on the A429 Kenilworth Road we will need to close the road to carry out the permanent connection works. These works will be carried in two phases:

Phase one: We will close the A429 Kenilworth Road from **2 September 2024 to 29 September 2024 to carry out the following works:**

- Relocation of multiple sets of utilities to the new road alignment
- Completion of the earthworks to build the embankments

Phase two: These works will be carried out in early 2025, once a date is confirmed we will send a further notification regarding the final dates, works will include:

- Final relocation of multiple sets of utilities
- Completion of the final earthworks and carriageway connections

When will these works be taking place?

These works will be carried out from **2 September 2024 to 29 September 2024**. The closure will be in place 24 hours a day, a fully signposted diversion route will remain throughout the closure. Access for properties, pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained.

A429 Kenilworth Road will be closed from **2 September 2024 to 29 September 2024**

Kenilworth Road will remain open for pedestrians and cyclists and access to properties

The closure will be in place 24 hours a day

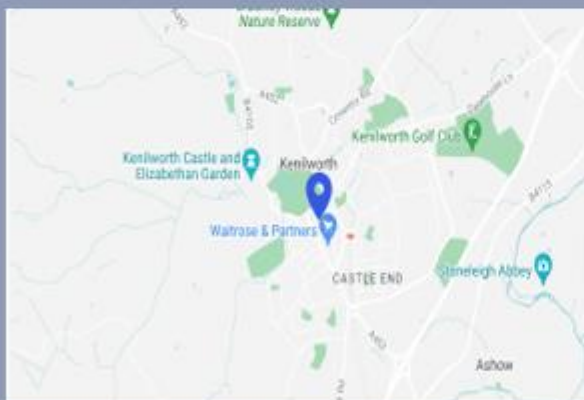
