

Overnight closure of Moorhall Road, Hillingdon, for parapet installation

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Align JV is building the Colne Valley viaduct, which crosses Moorhall Road in London Borough of Hillingdon.

What works need to take place?

Align JV is currently building the 3.4km Colne Valley viaduct from the North Embankment at Denham in Buckinghamshire to the South Embankment near Harvil Road in Hillingdon. The decking of the viaduct over Moorhall Road has already been completed however we now need to install parapets – walls either side of the deck. We have already installed some parapets along the viaduct, as illustrated below, but to install the sections safely over the public highway we will need to close Moorhall Road to all users overnight from Monday 12 August 2024 to Sunday 25 August 2024 between 10pm and 6am every night.

Traffic will be diverted during these times. Details of the road diversion are shown overleaf.



Over 1500 parapets needed for the entire length of the viaduct.

Duration of works

Monday 12 August 2024 to Sunday 25 August 2024. Works are taking place overnight from 10pm to 6am Monday to Sunday.

What to expect

Overnight closure of Moorhall Road in both directions.

Some noise and additional lighting.

These works are weather dependent, so dates may need to change.

What we will do

Marshalled and signed access for residents and businesses.

Signed diversion for traffic on local diversion route.

If for any reason we are not working, we will not close the road that evening.

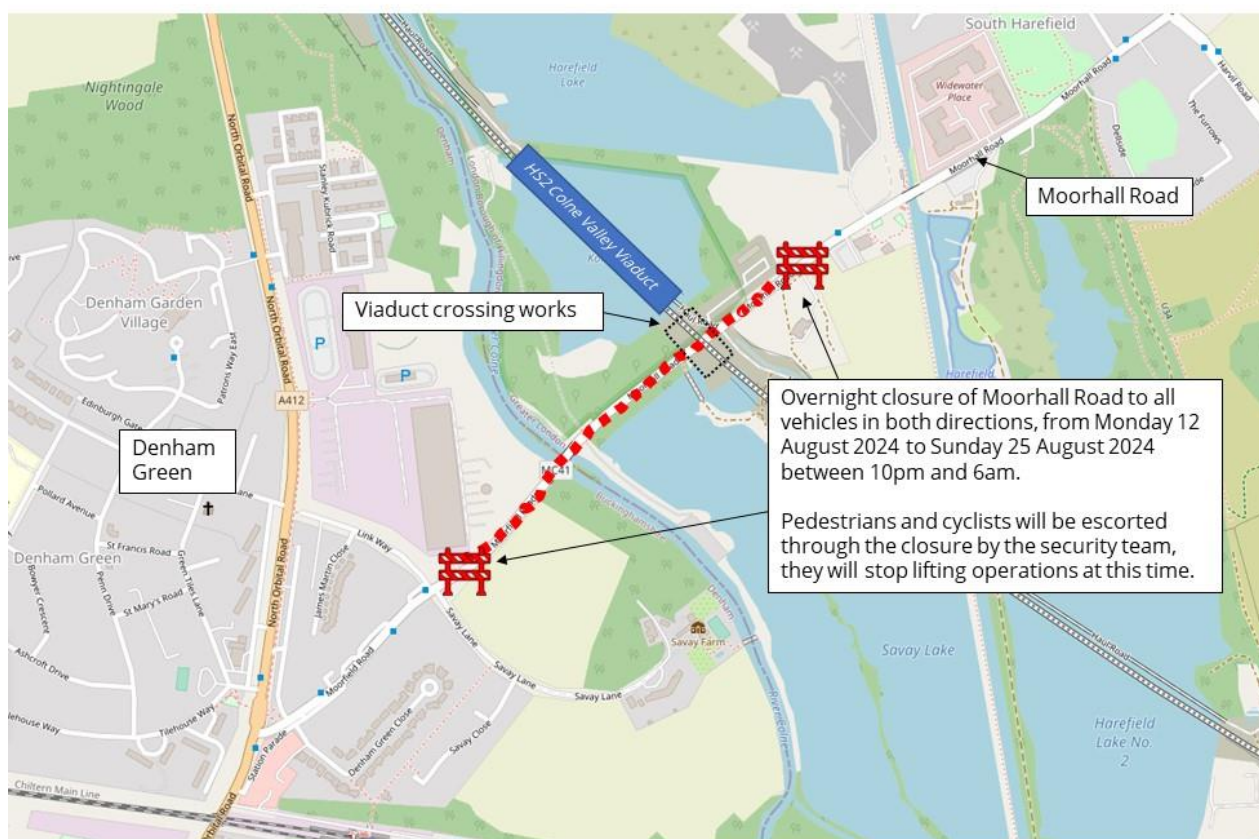

What route will pedestrians and cyclists take during the road closure?

Cyclists and pedestrians will be guided through the road closure point by a signed route during the periods of closure.

How will this affect the route 331 bus?

The route 331 bus from Uxbridge to Ruislip (via Denham) will be re-routed during the periods of full road closure of Moorhall Road.

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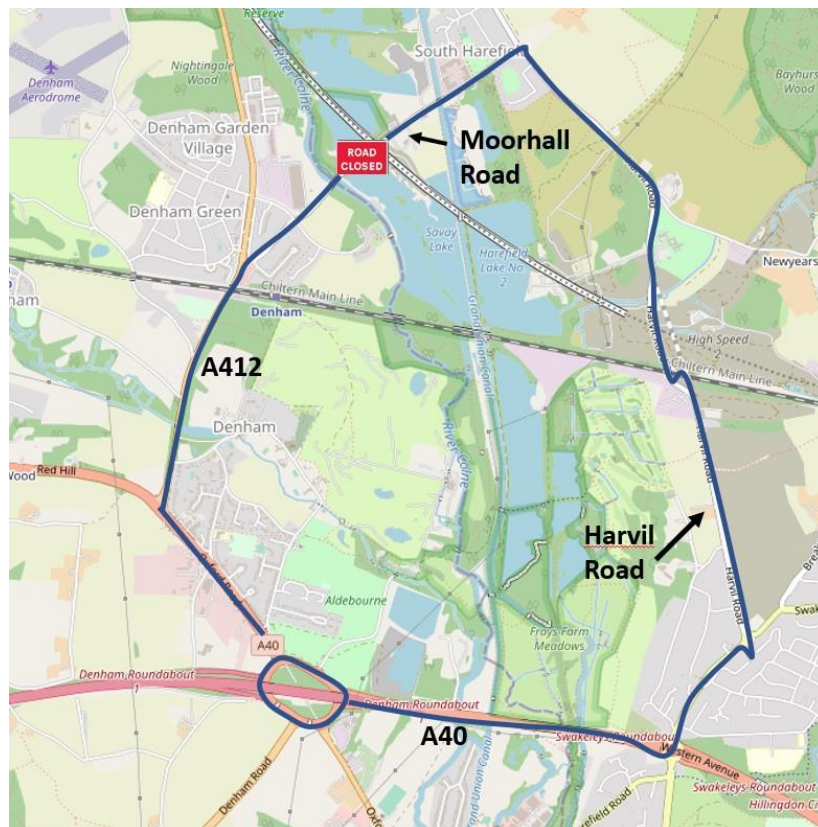
