What are we doing?

This summer we will be installing safety barriers along the A423. These barriers are required as construction continues so we can work close to the carriageway safely. To install the barriers and carry out works along the roadside, there will be a weekend road closure on the A423, Banbury Road.

There will also be a single day time road closure of a section of the B4451 Kineton Road, to complete trial holes for upcoming utility diversions. These works are to facilitate the ongoing construction of the Kineton Road Overbridge.

When will these works take place?

A section of the A423, Banbury Road, near Southam will be closed on Saturday 20 July and Sunday 21 July, from 8.30am to 5.30pm.

A section of the B4451, Kineton Road, will be closed near Southam on Thursday 25 July, from 8.30am to 3.30pm.

These dates may be subject to change, due to circumstances outside of our control, such as poor weather. This work is subject to local authority consents and approvals.

Duration of works

A section of the A423, Banbury Road, will be closed on Saturday 20 July and Sunday 21 July from 8.30am to 5.30pm.

A section of B4451, Kineton Road, will be closed on Thursday 25 July from 8.30am to 3.30pm.

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Road closures and construction activities in the highway.

Access will be maintained for properties within the closure areas.



A section of the A423, Banbury Road, between Ladbrooke and Southam will be closed from 8.30am to 5.30pm on Saturday 20 July and Sunday 21 July 2024.

Access will be maintained for properties within the closure area, including properties on Starbold Farm.

Where will the works take place?

The map below, shows the approximate area of the B4451, Kineton Road, that will be closed from 8.30am to 3.30pm, Thursday 25 July 2024.

Access will be maintained for all properties within the closure area, as well as for the sports clubs. The closure area is located south of the business park and Lark Road, so full access to the retail and sport facilities is available from the A425, Leamington Road.
