# **Vegetation Clearance Update**

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. BBVS is the contractor working on behalf of HS2 to construct the Old Oak Common station.

### What are we doing

We recently contacted you regarding vegetation clearance and tree felling, which took place between May and June 2024: **Advanced Notice** Letter; HS2-MW-BBVS-Ph1-OOC-St-S4-CR-31-24/02/2024 delivered on 13 May 2024.

We need to revisit the area west of Wells House Road, to complete the tree felling and vegetation clearance. These areas are outstanding from the last phase of work in June, and not reliant on a possession of the London north line. The clearance will be in the locations identified on the map below between late July and early August 2024.

The work, which will include logging the trees once they have been felled, will take place during normal working hours, 8am - 6pm.
