What are we doing?

In early September, EKFB will be installing a reinforced plant crossing on Ladbroke Hill Lane. To achieve this, Ladbroke Hill Lane will be fully closed, 24 hours a day, for approximately two weeks starting Monday 2 September.

A strengthened road surface will be created using concrete to ensure that we protect the road and any utilities underneath it for the duration of our works. This crossing will enable our construction traffic to pass over the road. As the works will require large plant and machinery, and time for concrete to set, we are required to fully close these sections of road, 24 hours per day. This is for the safety of road users and our staff, due to the lane being narrow.

Access will be maintained for local farms, business and the footpath SM90, during the closure.

It may also be necessary to remove localised areas of vegetation to enable future works to continue and to allow access to areas of the site.

When will these works take place?

Ladbroke Hill Lane will be fully closed, 24-hours a day, from 19 August to 30 August 2024.

These dates may be subject to local authority consents and changes due to circumstances outside of our control, such as poor weather.

Monday 19 August to Friday 30 August 2024, 24 hours a day.

Working hours: 8am to 6pm

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

Full road closure.

Access will be maintained for residents, businesses and the public right of way.

What we will do

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

Access will be maintained for residents as well as emergency services within the closure area.

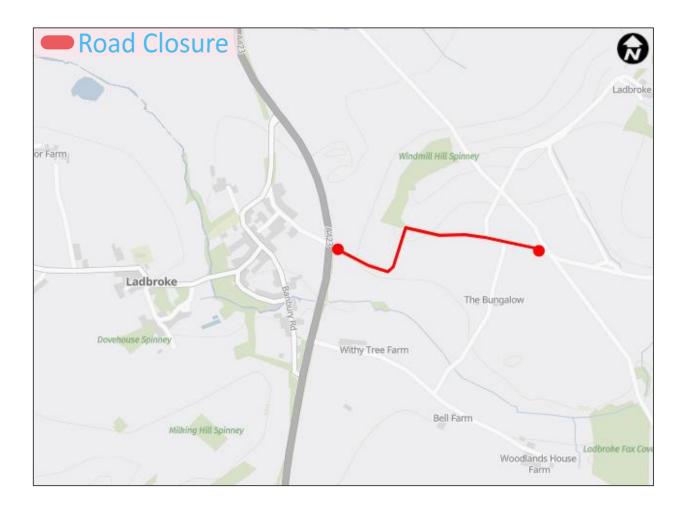
