



Lane closure on A413, Little Missenden

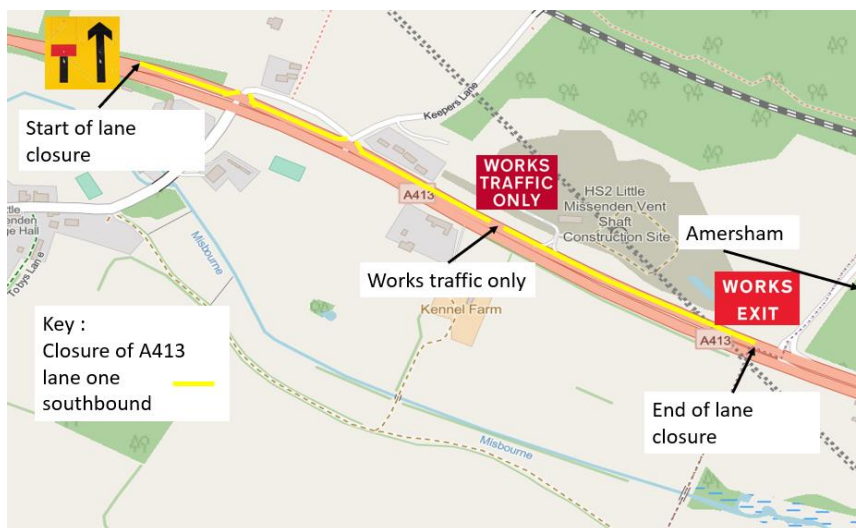
High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. This notification is to inform you of a temporary lane closure on the A413, in Little Missenden, to undertake visibility splay surveys.

How will these works affect you?

We will close one lane of the A413 travelling southbound from Little Missenden towards Amersham to facilitate survey works. The second lane will remain operational and traffic management will be installed during the duration of the works. The lane closure will occur from 9.30am to 3.30pm on Wednesday 4 September 2024.

What will we be doing?

A small team will be present in the closed section undertaking surveys for marking out of visibility splays. These will enable drivers exiting our Little Missenden site to see vehicles approaching along the A413 clearly and exit safely. To undertake the surveys a section of the A413 lane one, southbound, will be temporarily closed and reopened once the surveys are complete.

These works will take place on Wednesday 4 September from 9.30am to 3.30pm

What to expect

Single lane closure of the A413 southbound outside our Little Missenden site

Operatives visible and working in the area

Fully signed traffic management will be in place

Lane two will remain open

We will reopen lane one as soon as we are able to do so
