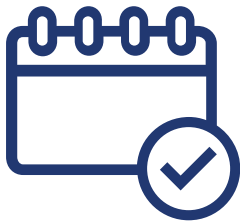
What are we doing?

In August and September, we will be carrying out works on sections of the new of A41 and Blackgrove Road, which opened to the public in May this year. We will also be working on sections of the old A41 Bicester Road.

There will be 2-way a 3-way temporary traffic lights in place while we complete these works which will include permanent signage, street lighting installation and general carriageway works.

To reduce impact on road users, the traffic lights on the A41 Bicester Road will only be in operation at off-peak times and access will be maintained for residents along the A41 and Blackgrove Road.

When will these works take place?



- **Monday 19 – Wednesday 28 August, new A41 and Blackgrove Road lane closure, 3-way traffic lights 8:30am-5:30pm**
- **Monday 26 August – Friday 13 September, A41 Bicester Road lane closure, 2-way traffic lights 9am-3pm**

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.

Duration of works

Daytime lane closure with 3-way and 2-way lights along the new A41 (formerly Blackgrove Road) 19-28 August.

Off peak daytime lane closure with 2-way lights along A41 Bicester Road 26 August – Friday 13 September.

What to expect

Daytime lane closure with 3-way/2-way traffic lights. Varied activities with quieter and busier periods. Increased travel time.

What we will do

Minimise disruption as much as possible for the community.

Provide updates for communities and maintain regular contact points for the duration of the work.

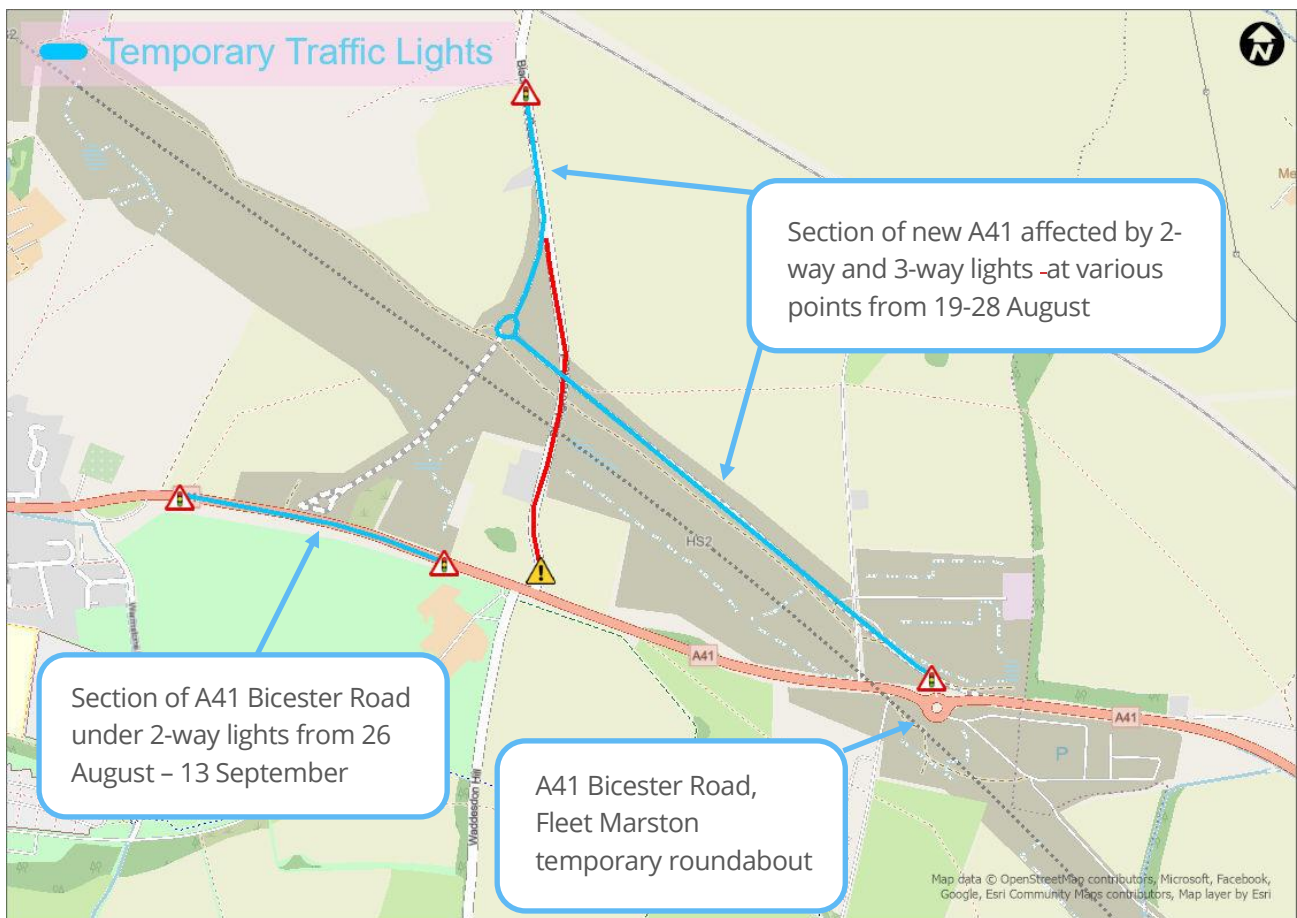

Where will these works take place?

The map below shows the sections of the new A41 and Blackgrove Road under traffic management. The nature of these works require the temporary traffic lights at various locations within the affected stretch of road highlighted in blue in August, not the entire section.

The map also shows the section of A41 Bicester Road which will be under traffic management during August and September.
