Cable diversion works

From **7am to 2pm on the weekends of 12 and 13 and 19 and 20 October**, we will be diverting some electrical cables located on the south-eastern corner of the Mandeville Road site (see image below).

The cables will be cut and pulled into position using a mechanical winch. Works will take place at the weekend, so it does not interfere with critical weekday activities.

Noise and vibration monitoring will be in place at all times. We will also use acoustic barriers around the machinery to reduce the noise as much as possible.



We would like to apologise for any disruption or inconvenience this may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way. We will keep disruption to a minimum.
