High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inyourarea.co.uk.

What are we doing?

This autumn, we will be carrying out works along School End, Chetwode Grange Road, Main Street and Preston Bissett Road. Due to the wet weather, dates for some of our works have now been moved to early November.

We will be carrying out survey activities and clearing some localised areas of vegetation. These works will facilitate the continued construction of the main structures we are building in the area. For reasons of safety and due to the narrow width of the roads, these works will require some road closures.

Our teams will also continue carrying out utility works and duct installation for the permanent road realignment of the junction of Main Street and Preston Bissett Road. We will continue to update communities as our works progress.

When will these works take place?

A section of School End will be closed during the day between the hours of 8.30am-5.30pm on the following dates:

- Monday 4 November to Friday 8 November
- Monday 18 November to Friday 22 November

A section of School End will be close 24-hours a day on the following dates:

- Tuesday 10 December to Saturday 15 December
- Tuesday 17 December to Friday 20 December

A section of Main Street will close 24-hours a day, for works on the following dates:

- Monday 25 November to Friday 20 December

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control such as weather. These works are subject to consents.

Duration of works

A section of **School End** will be closed during the day, 8.30am to 5.30pm, from

Monday 4 November to Friday 8 November.

Monday 18 November to Friday 22 November.

A section of **Main Street** will be closed 24-hours a day on the following dates:

Access will be maintained for residents located within the closure area.

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise

Respond promptly to any complaints.
