What are we doing?

In September, we will be reinstating the plant crossing on the A418 Oxford Road near the EKFB compound. This is to facilitate materials deliveries between our sites.

The crossing will be used for transporting stone and other material from one side of the A418 Oxford Road to the other, for use in the construction of Thame Valley Viaduct.

As such, 2-way traffic signals will be necessary to manage the crossing point for 2 days. To minimise disruption to road users these will be in operation during off-peak hours only.

When will these works take place?

- **Tuesday 17 to Wednesday 18 September – plant crossing managed by 2-way traffic lights, 9:30am-3pm**

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.
