What are we doing?

We will be carrying out utility trial hole surveys on the B4451 Kineton Road, at the roundabout with Lark Road, near Southam Trading Estate.

The trial holes will allow us to accurately identify and inspect the existing utilities that are located under Kineton Road, as part of preparations for the Kineton Road overbridge.

Due to the location of the surveys at the roundabout, a two-day road closure will be required followed by two days with four-way traffic lights.

We will carry out the surveys as quickly as possible and may remove the traffic lights earlier than planned if progress allows.

When will these works take place?

The B4451, Kineton Road, will have a road closure from 8.30am to 5.30pm from Tuesday 1 October to Thursday 3 October.

These dates may be subject to local authority consents and changes due to circumstances outside of our control, such as poor weather.

Duration of works

The B4451 Kineton Road will have a road closure on 1 to 3 October 2024

Normal Working hours:

Monday to Friday:

8.30am to 5.30pm

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

A road closure and temporary traffic lights on the B4451 for utility trial holes.

Access will be maintained for residents and sports clubs.




Where will the works take place?

The map below shows the road closure on the B4451 Kinton Road and the diversion route.

The closure area is located south of the business park and Lark Road, so full access to the retail and sport facilities is available from the Southam direction.

Access will be maintained from the south for residential properties within the closure area and Southam Rugby Club.
