Reason for clearance:		Essential utilities works within the root protection areas of trees within Ampthill Estate are required as part of the transfer of the existing utilities from Hampsted Road Bridge into Granby Terrace Bridge.  Works will involve the excavation of trial pits to check for obstructions within the area in preparation for utilities works in the area, to identify ducts for reuse.  The location of the trial holes are constrained by the current UKPN easement (a right to cross or otherwise use someone else's land for a specified purpose) that is in place.

Have all practicable means to negate need for works to tree been investigated? Please provide details The purpose of the pruning is to confirm existing utilities and ground conditions and suitability of the proposed route of permanent UKPN cable route and possible reuse of existing ducts.

The location of the trial holes are constrained by the current UKPN easement (a right to cross or otherwise use someone else's land for a specified purpose) that is in place.

As part of the site visit Arboricultural Consultant the location of the trial holes were agreed to meet the both UKPN encasement requirements and where possible minimise the interface with the trees and their root protection areas.

## Trees Affected and Scope of Works:

Two trees (T001 and T002) and 3m section of hedge (H001) along the Hampsted Road perimeter, plus a tree (T004) within the central grassed of the Ampthill Estate grounds.

Too2: Retained, but works in root protection area to be undertaken with hand tools and under arboricultural supervision, It is not anticipated to remove this tree as a result of the trial hole location, however, due to its current condition should during the progression of the works should it be recommended by the arboricultural supervision that the activity is likely to further impact the mortality of the tree it may require to be removed.

**Too4:** Retained, but works in root protection area to be undertaken with hand tools and under arboricultural supervision.

Hoo1: Removal of an approximate 3m section of the hedge.



Cable route from Hampstead Road to Gillfoot substation to provide power to substation and associated interaction with Tree Protection areas.





Size of replacement tree to be agreed with HS2  SCS are to replant any hedge removed as part of the trial hole work described above using the same species and ensure protective fencing (such as chestnut pale) is installed to protect the new planting and prevent the area becoming a short cut
