

# Notice of overnight road closures A413, London Road

## What are we doing?

In November, we will be undertaking multiple works at the Small Dean viaduct to prepare for the viaduct launch in early 2025. We will be required to complete trial holes in the verge of the road and commence the lifting of hammerhead units for the construction of the final pier.

As we need to protect the safety of our team working close to the carriageway, the A413, London Road will be closed for the duration of our works. The works will take place across a series of overnight road closures in November.

## When will these works take place?

Overnight road closures (8:30pm – 5:30am):

- **Tuesday 5 November to Friday 8 November**
- **Wednesday 13 November to Friday 15 November**
- **Tuesday 19 November to Thursday 21 November**

To minimise disruption, we will introduce a fully signposted diversion route and have chosen to work overnight to reduce our road impact.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control.

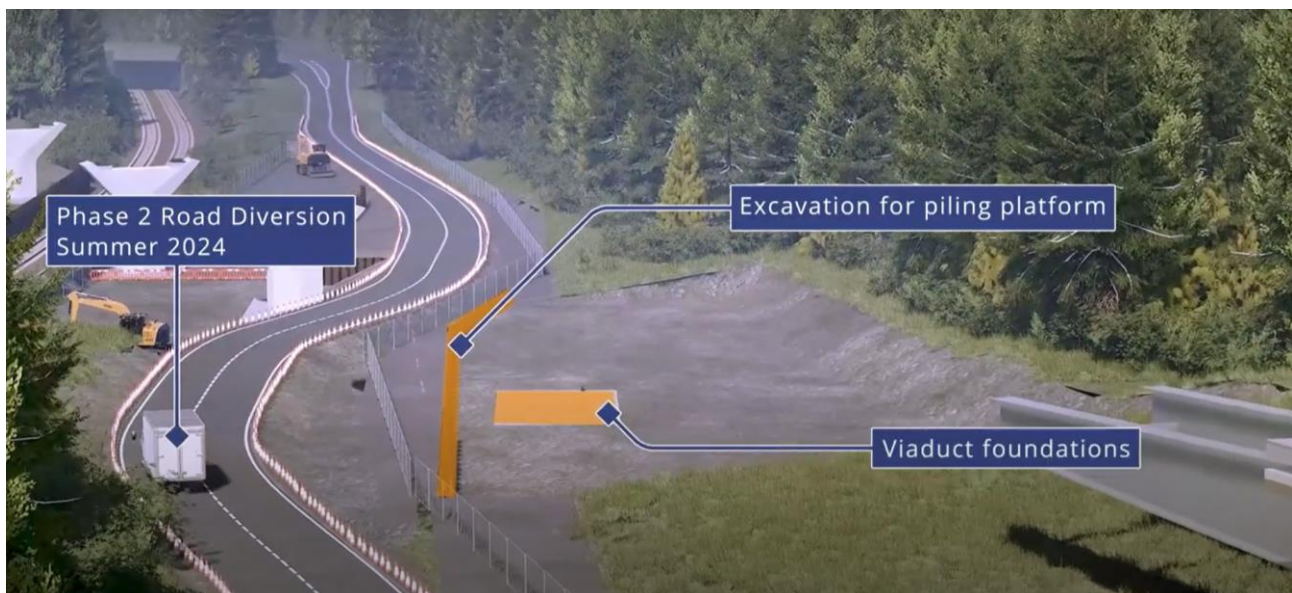


### Small Dean Viaduct construction phases video

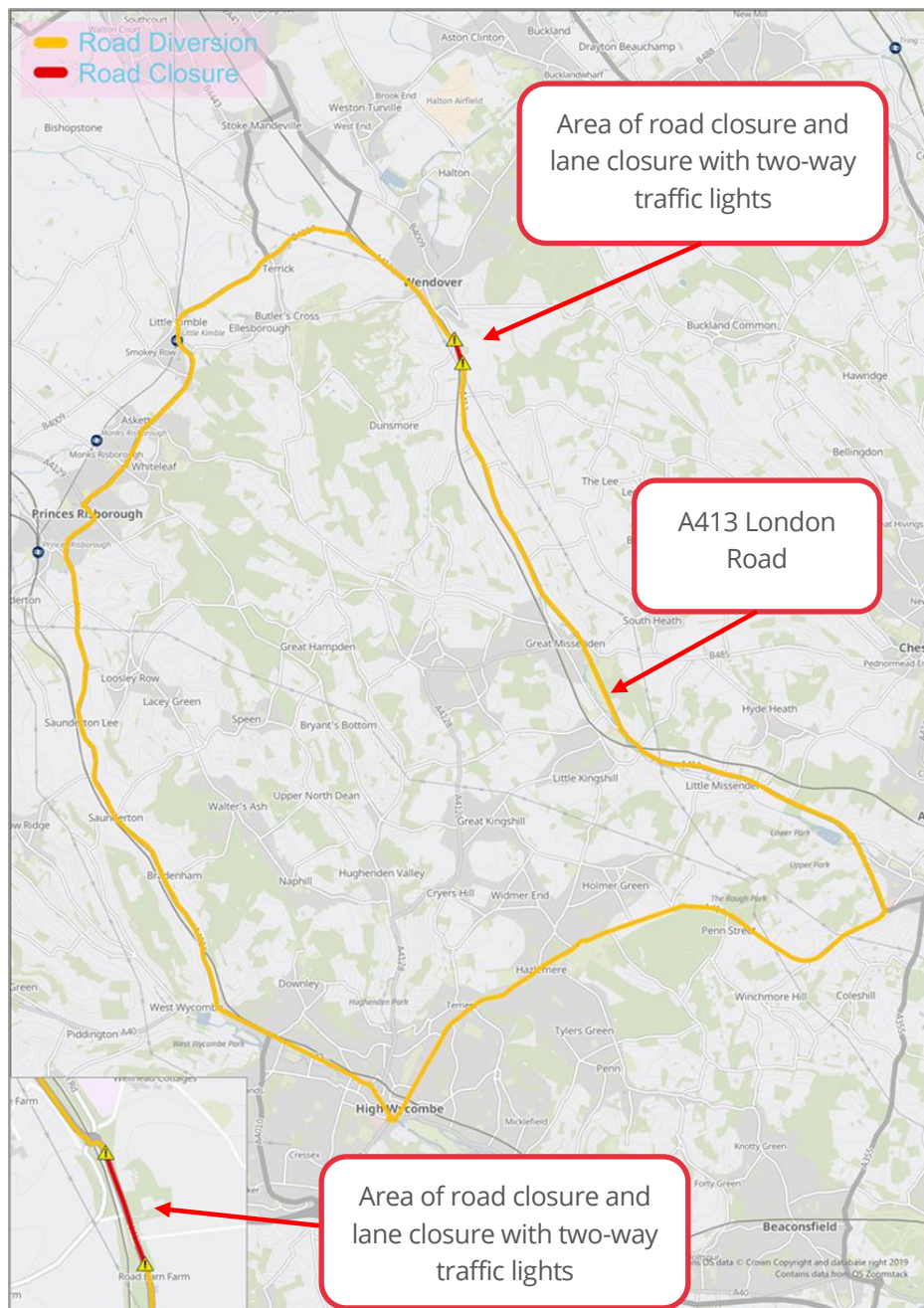
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## A413, London Road
