What Are We Doing?

In November, we will be carrying out utility works across Nash Lee Lane. This will involve an excavation of the road and installing ducting to complete the utility diversion.

For the duration of the closure, we will be providing temporary access to Nash Lee Lane via our work site.

For reasons of safety, as our teams will be working in the carriageway, a section of the road will be closed.

When will these works take place?

A section of Nash Lee Lane will be fully closed from:

- **Saturday 2 November 8:00am to 6:00pm**

A local diversion using part of the EKFB site access road will be sign posted.

We will work to open the roads to reduce disruption as soon as possible, however there is a contingency date if we are unable to complete the works during the day closure.

Should there be delays to our works, these dates may be subject to change.

Take care to respect the community.

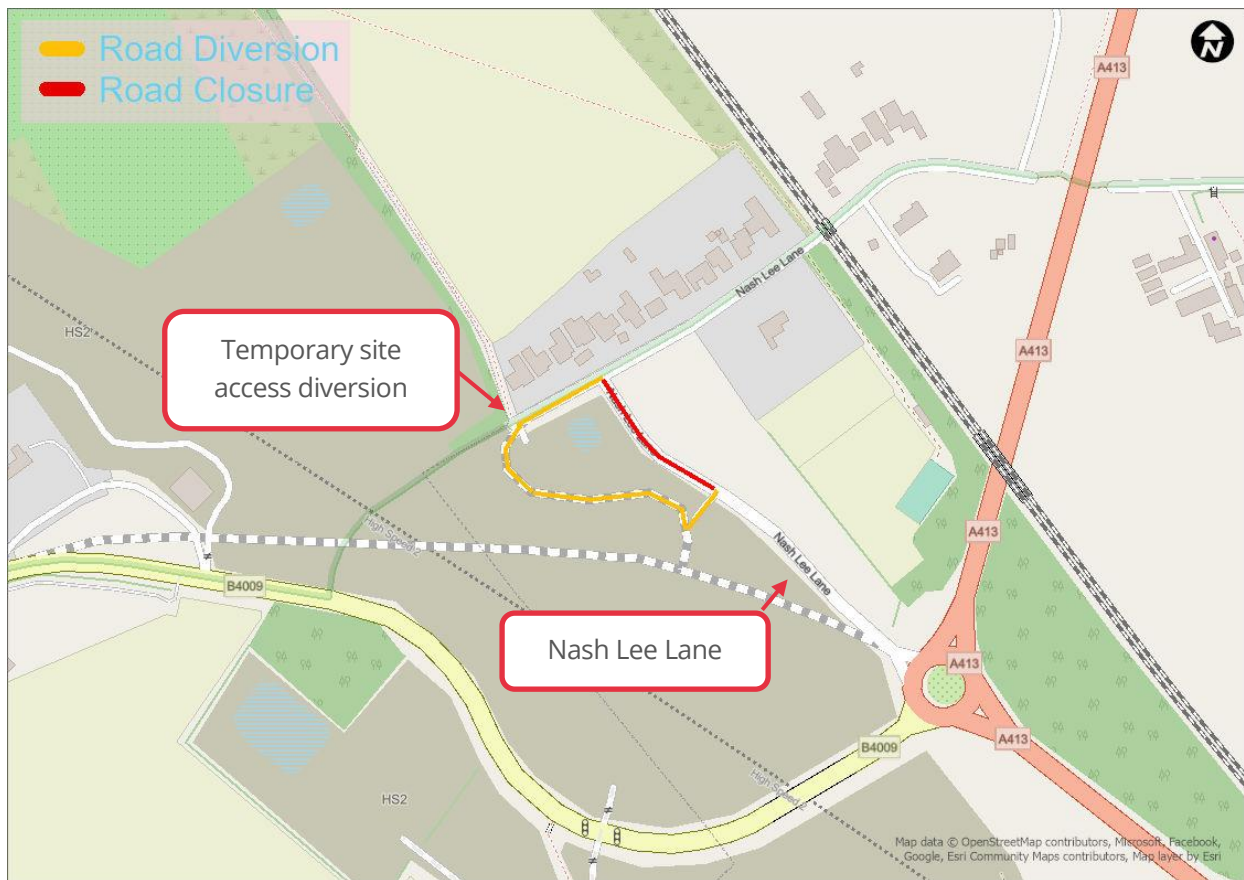
