What are we doing?

In November, we will be carrying out utility works across Nash Lee Road. This will involve an excavation of the road and rerouting utilities under the road to complete a utility diversion.

As the works will require our workforce to be on the carriageways, we need to introduce a closure of Nash Lee Road for the safety of road users and our workforce. Pedestrian access will not be maintained due to the nature of these works.

Throughout these works The Chiltern Brewery will be open as usual, access will be from the Terrick end of Nash Lee Road.

When will these works take place?

A section of Nash Lee Road will be fully closed from:

• Saturday 9 November 8:00am - Sunday 10 November 6:00pm

These dates are subject to change due to circumstances beyond our control. Should we finish the works early, the road closure will be removed.
