High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty Vinci (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

To continue for our preparation of the HS2 railway we will be completing works on Gilson Drive by installing traffic management to complete NGED connections and reinstatement works.


When the work will take place

Update: Due to changes in the works program and to complete the works safely, the Gilson Drive road closure will now be in place each weekday from Wednesday 13 November to Friday 29 November. The closure will be in place from 7:30am to 17:30pm each day.

Access will be maintained to residents and deliveries using traffic management marshals.

UPDATE: The road closure will be in place each weekday from Wednesday 13 November to Friday 29 November. This will be in place each weekday from 7:30am to 17:30pm
