



UPDATED: Notice of road closure on Attleboro Lane for utility diversions

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty Vinci (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

In order to prepare for our continued construction of the HS2 railway we will be undertaking our final utility diversion works on Attleboro Lane. The works will include utility diversions for Severn Trent Water, National Grid and BT. Once complete, the road will be reinstated and reopened.

Traffic management will be installed to ensure the safety of the workers and public to complete the works.

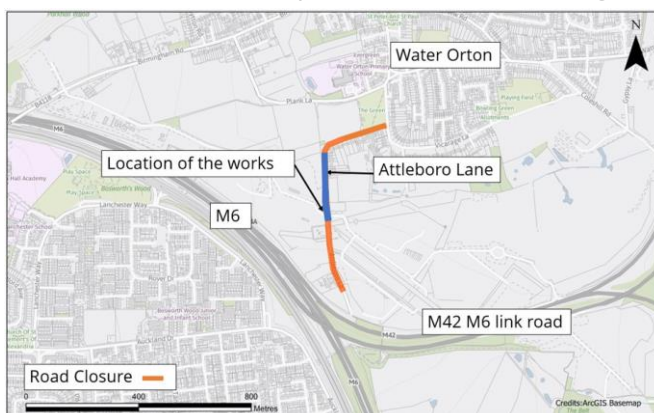
When the work will take place

UPDATE: Road closures will be in place on Attleboro Lane each weekday from Wednesday 6 November to Friday 20 December. The closure will be in place from 7:30am to 5pm each day. Additionally, a closure will also be in place on Saturday 14 December to remove overhead cables.

Access will be maintained to residents and deliveries using a traffic management marshal. All other vehicles will use the diversion in place.

UPDATE: Road closure will be in place each weekday from Wednesday 6 November to Friday 20 December from 7:30am to 5pm. An additional closure will be in place on Saturday 14 December.
