High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Lorry deliveries near Juniper Crescent and Gilbey's Yard

During 2025, we will be carrying out some protection works in your local area, including works to protect the Grade II* Listed Camden Winding Engine Vaults beneath the current railway. The underground vaults housed two stationary steam engines, between 1837 and 1844, to power a rope to haul trains up the steep approach to Euston from the Fitzroy Bridge.

From **1 December 2024 to 23 February 2025** we will be carrying out some enabling works next to the railway track and within the underground vaults. The works include installing scaffolding to allow safe access, and non-intrusive surveys to confirm what protective works we may need to do. Scaffolding equipment and a lorry mounted crane will travel by road using the existing rail access point on Juniper Crescent. Deliveries will take place every Sunday when trains are not using the tracks, between 1am and 7am. Survey works will take place during 8am – 6pm. Please refer to the map below.

Within this time there may be periods of noisy works when lifting materials from the crane onto our site. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.
