



## Update notice of extended temporary lights, Stoneleigh crossroads, Ashow Road B4115

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

### The work we will be doing

We previously notified you of the four-way temporary traffic lights at the Stoneleigh Crossroad on Ashow Road. The lights are in place to improve the road safety for vehicles coming from the A46 and turning right onto Ashow Road (B4115).

The temporary traffic lights will be required until **Monday 30 June 2027. The traffic lights are in place 24/7.**

### What to expect

Ashow Road remains open with traffic signals in operation to help vehicles enter and exit the access into the BBV compound.

You may notice minor disruption to your journey time. Please see map on page 2.
