The work we are doing

We are progressing construction of Welsh Road Underbridge and the new road realignment. We will be undertaking works on the new road realignment to start connecting it to the existing road. To commence this phase of works safely we will install temporary traffic lights. The following phase of works will require a temporary road closure in the New Year.

When the work will be taking place

These works will be carried out on **Monday 6 January 2025 to Monday** 27 January 2025 with temporary traffic lights in place 24/7.

What to expect

You may notice increased construction activity with minor travel disruptions to your journey. Once the temporary traffic lights have been removed, a closure will be in place to complete final stages of the tie-in connections. We will confirm the closure dates in the New Year.

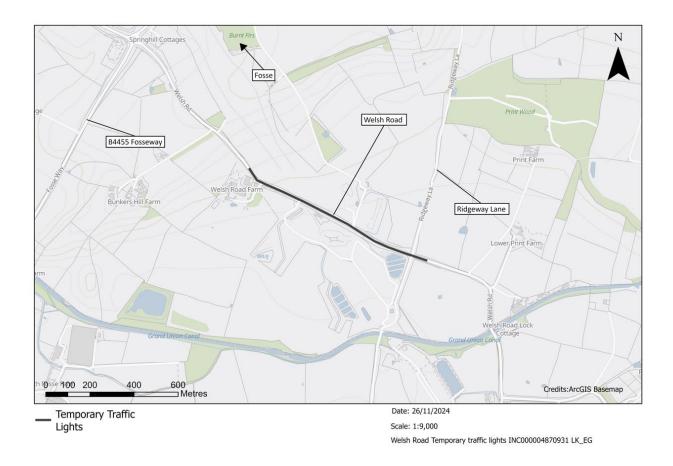
