



Leather Lane road closure, Great Missenden / The Lee, for culvert instalment works

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. This notice is to update you on a temporary road closure of Leather Lane, Great Missenden / The Lee to undertake culvert instalment works.

How will these works affect you?

Leather Lane will be temporarily closed to traffic from 9.30am on Thursday 28 November to midnight on Sunday 1 December, after which the traffic management will be removed. Traffic will be diverted via Potter Row, Frith Hill, and Aylesbury Road (A413) during the closure. Please see the map below.

The farmer's access will be maintained throughout the closure period.

What will we be doing?

We are installing two culverts that will link our attenuation pond north of Leather Lane to our water management system in South Heath. This will remove the need to use a tractor and bowser to carry water between these areas, which is our current method, and reduce vehicle movements between the site via the Leather Lane crossing.

HS2 commitments

HS2 has a commitment to Buckinghamshire Council which states that Leather Lane cannot be closed at the same time as Rocky Lane and Bowood Lane, unless the requirements have met the reasonably practicable request.

As it is unsafe to for our operatives to work in the single lane highway with live traffic Leather Lane will be temporarily closed to traffic and cyclists and has been agreed by Buckinghamshire Council.

- Maintain access for the farmer from the western side of Leather Lane

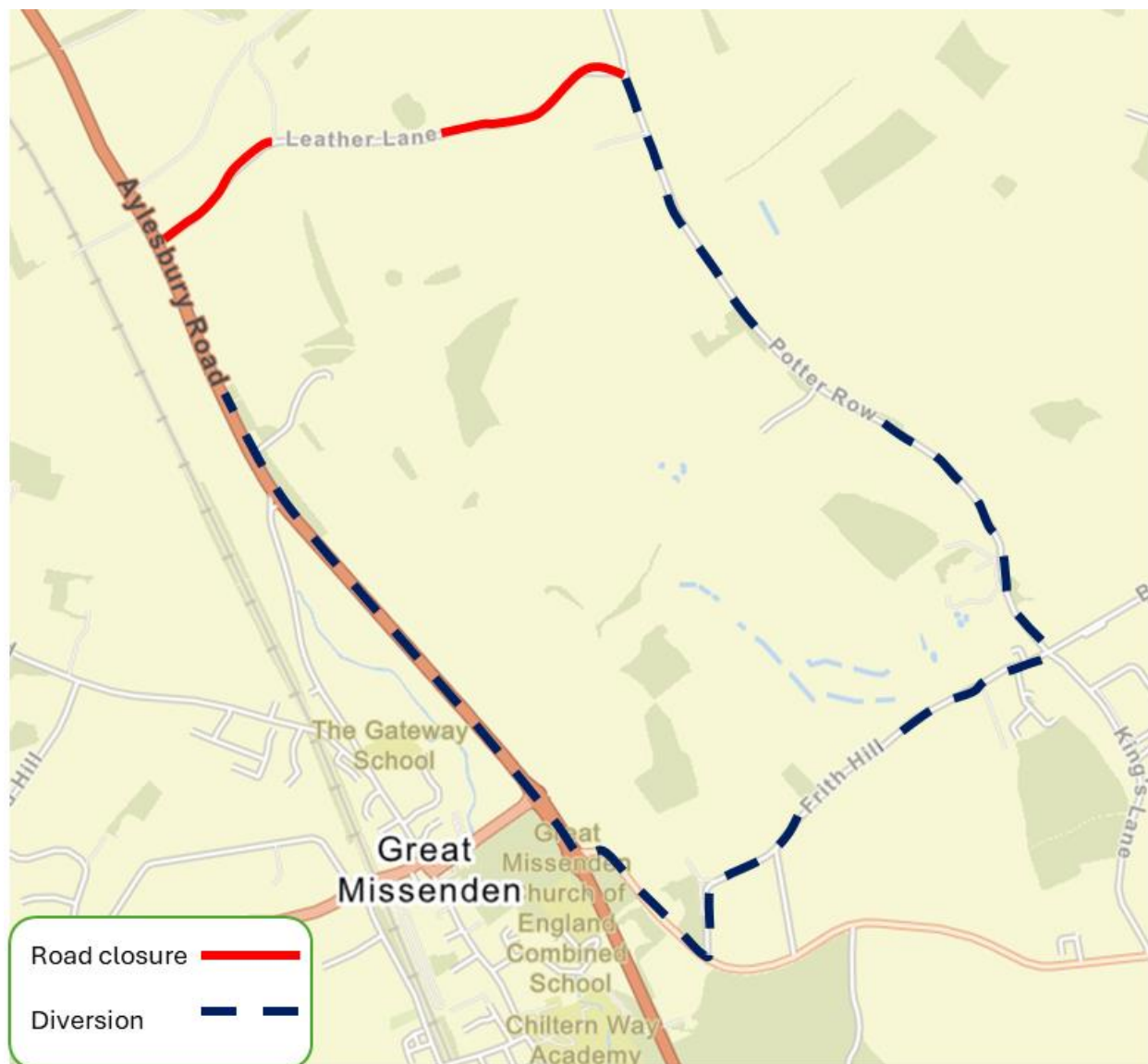
