



Notice of lane closures and road closures, A41 Bicester Road and **Blackgrove Road**

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. If you have any questions or enquiries about our work, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inyourarea.co.uk.

What are we doing?

During November and December 2024 and late January 2025, we will be carrying out finishing works at several locations along the newly aligned A41 Bicester Road up to Blackgrove Road, as well as laying and connecting new sections of gas pipe on both sides of the Fleet Marston temporary roundabout. The latter will include pressure testing. At times, the worksite within the lane closures may appear to be inactive while this takes place.

There will be lane closures on some sections of the new A41 Bicester Road, the old Bicester Road (formerly the A41) and Blackgrove Road. This will primarily be off peak working Mon-Fri but will also include limited weekend working and extended working hours as necessary.

There will be 2 overnight road closures on the A41 Bicester Road and Blackgrove Road in January 2025 to allow the removal of temporary road studs and to install permanent solar powered studs.

When will these works take place?



- Monday 25 November Friday 20 December, 2-way & 3-way traffic lights, 9am-3pm*
- **Thursday 23 January Saturday 25** January 2025, overnight road closures, 8:30pm-5:30am

*During this period, there will also be extended working hours and weekend working for a period of several to allow for SGN gas main connections and testing. This period will commence <u>7am Saturday</u> 14 December until 3pm Thursday 19 December during which time there will be lane closures on the A41 controlled by traffic lights.

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.




Where will these works take place?


Works will be carried out at various sections of the A41 Bicester Road, starting near the Fleet Marston roundabout and will finish at the end of the new A41 road alignment, Waddesdon village. Some of the work will be carried out on the Bicester Road (old A41) near the Fleet Marston temporary roundabout.

The map below shows the approximate area of the new A41 Bicester Road, the old Bicester Road (formerly the A41), and Blackgrove Road within which lane closures will be in effect between Monday 25 November to Friday 20 December.

*Note: the entire section of road shown in blue does not represent one large lane closure, it denotes the general area in which smaller sections of the road will be affected by lane closures during this period. Lane closures will be run one at a time, not concurrently.



The map below shows the area of the old Bicester Road being closed overnight between Thursday 23 and Saturday 25 January 2025, 8:30pm-5:30am.
