Notice of traffic lights and night working, A361, Chipping Warden

What are we doing?

We are continuing to prepare the A361 in Chipping Warden for the permanent realignment of the highway over the Chipping Warden Green Tunnel.

Throughout the autumn and winter, we are completing some utility works along the A361 near to the HS2 Chipping Warden Compound, just north of the village.

A section of the A361 will have traffic lights, incorporating the EKFB compound entrance, to complete this work. The exact location of the traffic lights will move as work progresses along the road.

For one week, we will be working at night so some additional lighting and activity will be required.

When will these works take place?

Saturday 5 October to Sunday 27 October 2024, 24 hours a day.

Update:

- 2 December to 5 December 2024, nighttime traffic management, 8.30pm to 5.30am.
- 9 December and 10 December, daytime traffic management incorporating the EKFB compound entrance, 8.30am to 5.30pm.

This work is subject to approvals from the local authority and the dates of the work may change.

Nighttime traffic management from Monday 2 December to Thursday 5 December 2024.

Daytime traffic management 9 December and 10 December 2024.

Working hours:

Nighttime: 8.30pm to 5.30am

Daytime: 8.30am to 5.30pm

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

Take care to respect the community.

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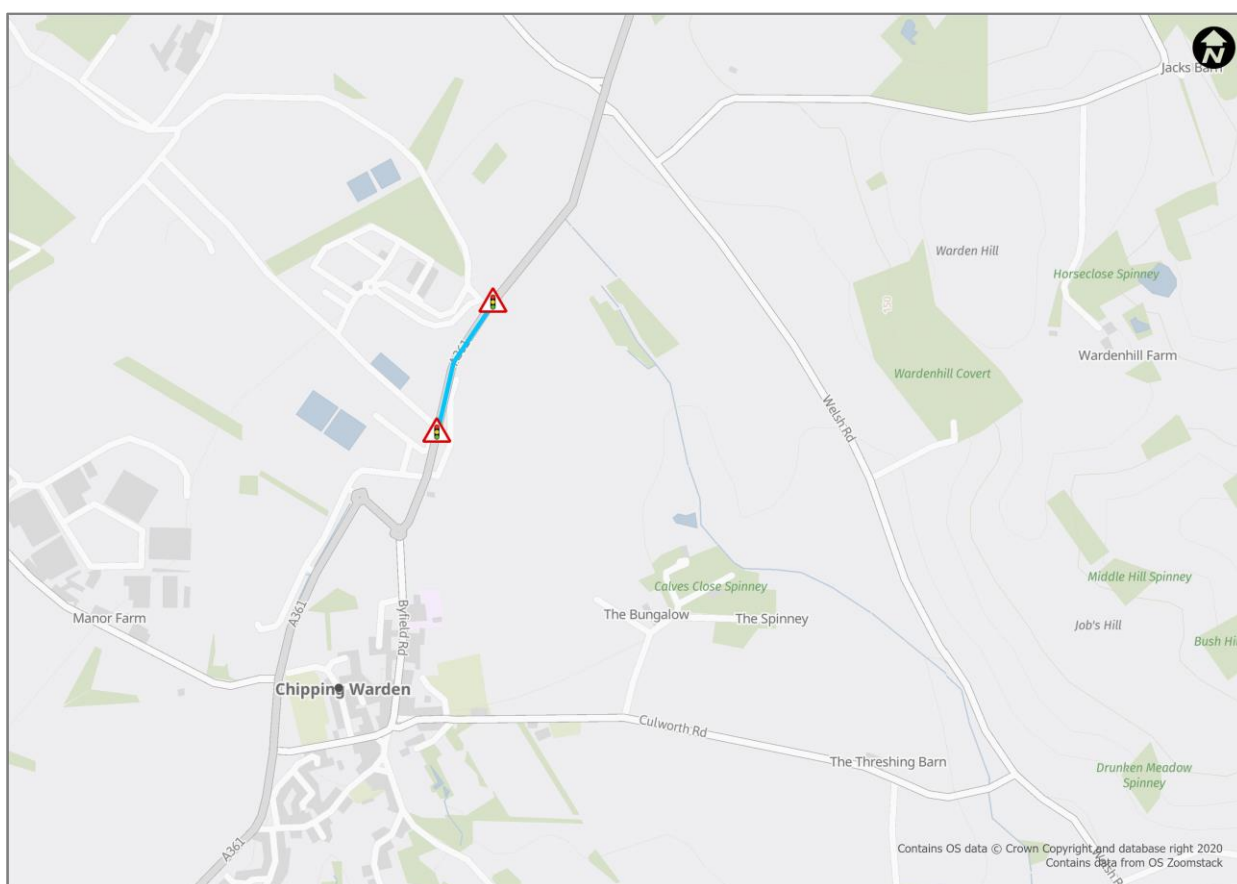
