



## Notice of overnight A452 northbound carriageway closures and lane closure – Bickenhill

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

### The work we will be doing

We will be progressing the next phase of the utility diversion along the A452 northbound carriageway.

To progress these works we will need to create a safe working area by closing a lane along the northbound carriageway. To install and remove the required traffic management for these works we will require:

Five overnight closures of the A452 northbound carriageway, between 10pm to 6am each night on:

- Monday 6 January 2025
- Tuesday 7 January 2025
- Friday 7 February 2025.
- Thursday 13 February 2025
- Friday 14 February 2025

There will be a single lane closure in place along the A452 from 7 January to 15 February 2025.

### Packington Lane access

Access to Packington Lane during these works:

- Overnight on 6 and 7 January 2025 will be via the A452 southbound only.
- From 8 January to 20 January 2025 access to Packington Lane will remain unaffected.
- From 20 January to 7 February 2025 access will be via the southbound entry slip road to the A452.
- From 7 February the A452 northbound exit will be reopened.

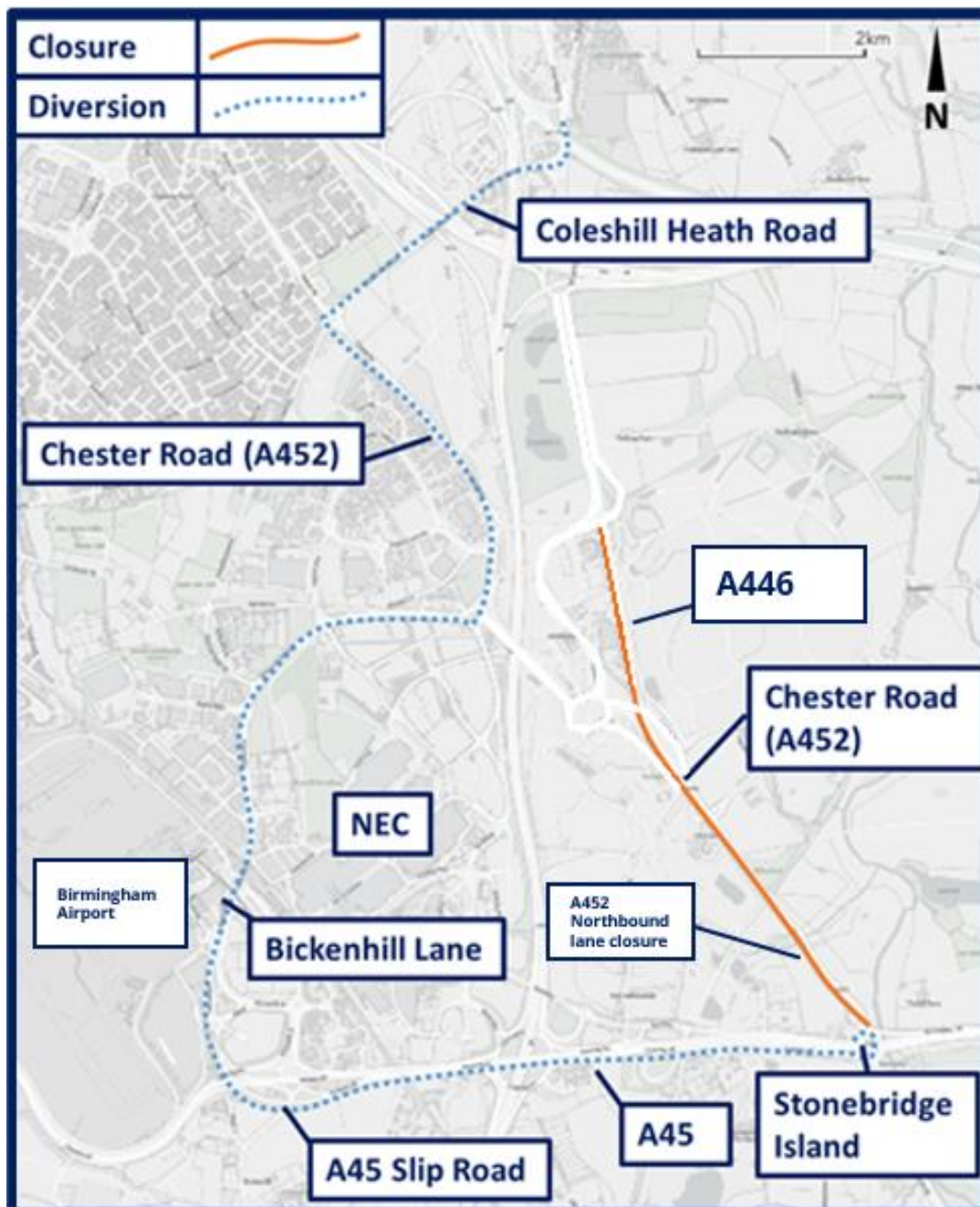

A452 northbound full overnight closure diversion single lane closure



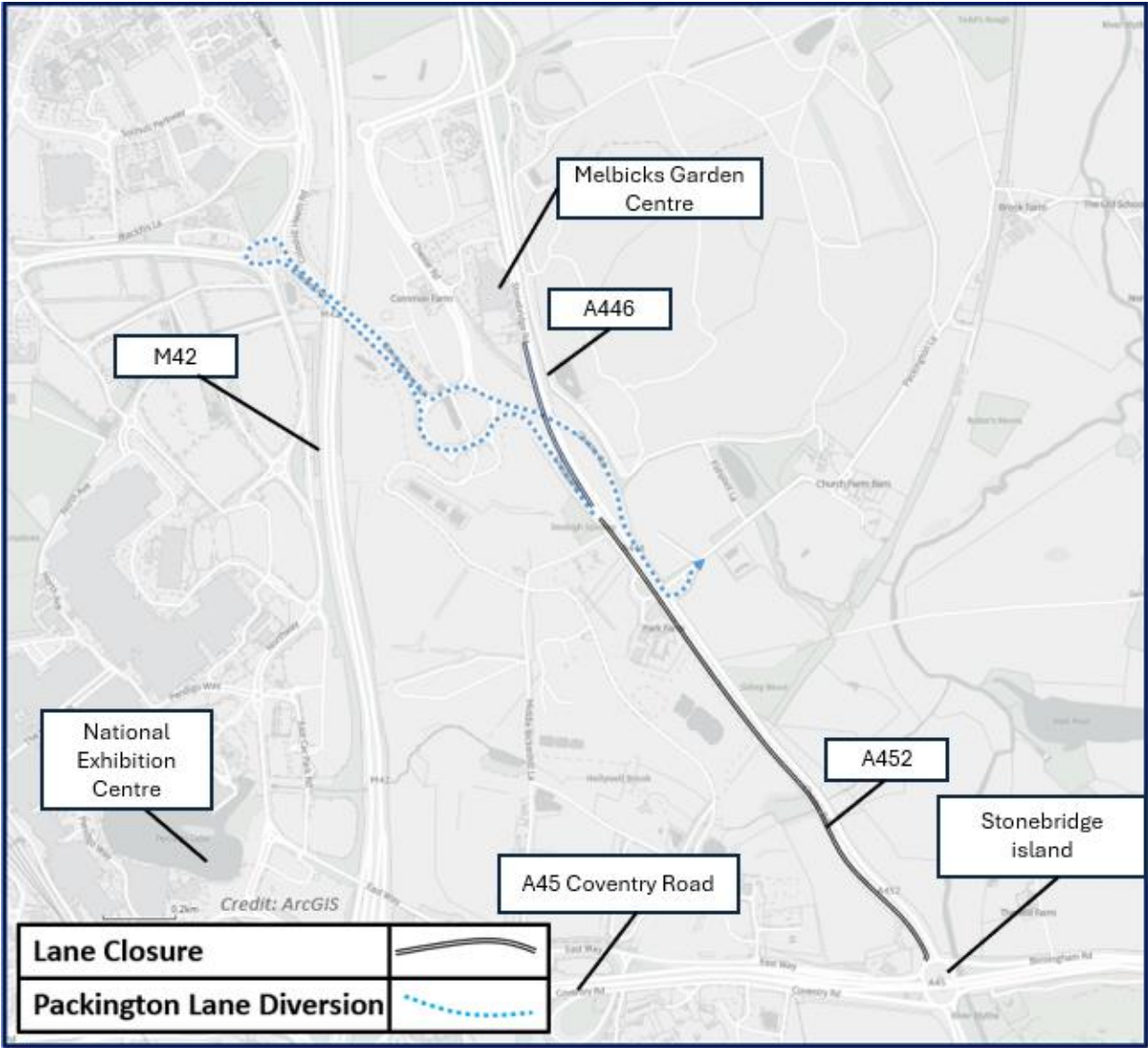
