High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area

The work we will be doing

We are continuing to progress with the construction of Hunningham Road Overbridge. We require a road closure, to carry out utility surveys, to locate existing utility services and prepare the ground for utility diversion works in 2025.

When these works will take place

These works will take place from **Monday 6 January to Friday 24 January 2024.**

The closure will be in place **24/7**

What to expect

You may notice increased construction activity with some travel disruptions to your journey.

There will be a signed diversion route in place during the closure. Access to all properties, for cyclists and pedestrians, will be maintained throughout.

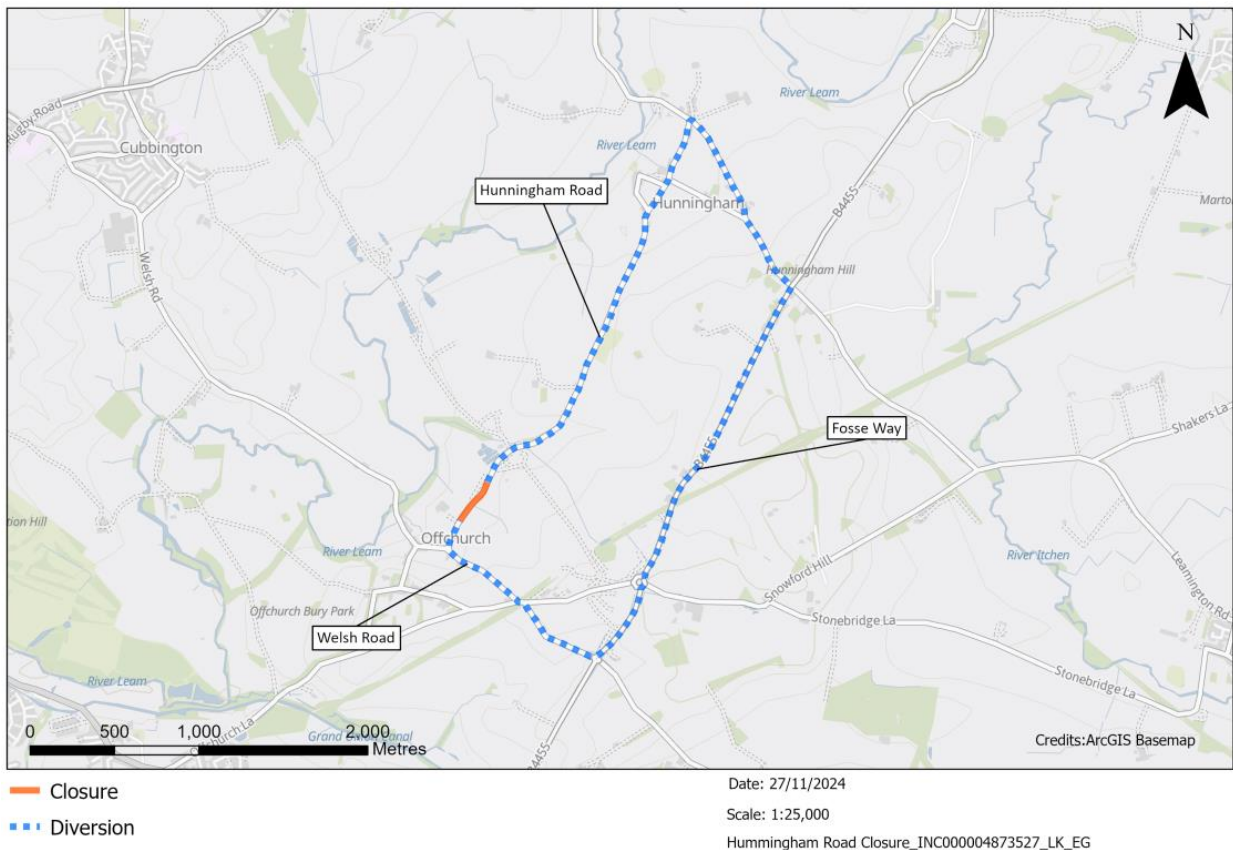
