High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing.

As we progress construction of the A429 Kenilworth Road Overbridge and road realignment, we need to carry out some additional utility trial hole work on the highway.

When will these works be taking place

The work will be done off-peak during the day between Tuesday 7 January to Friday 10 January 2025.

To carry out this work safely, we will install two-way temporary traffic lights and will be using vacuum excavation to complete the works. This will operate between **9.30 am** and **3.30 pm**.

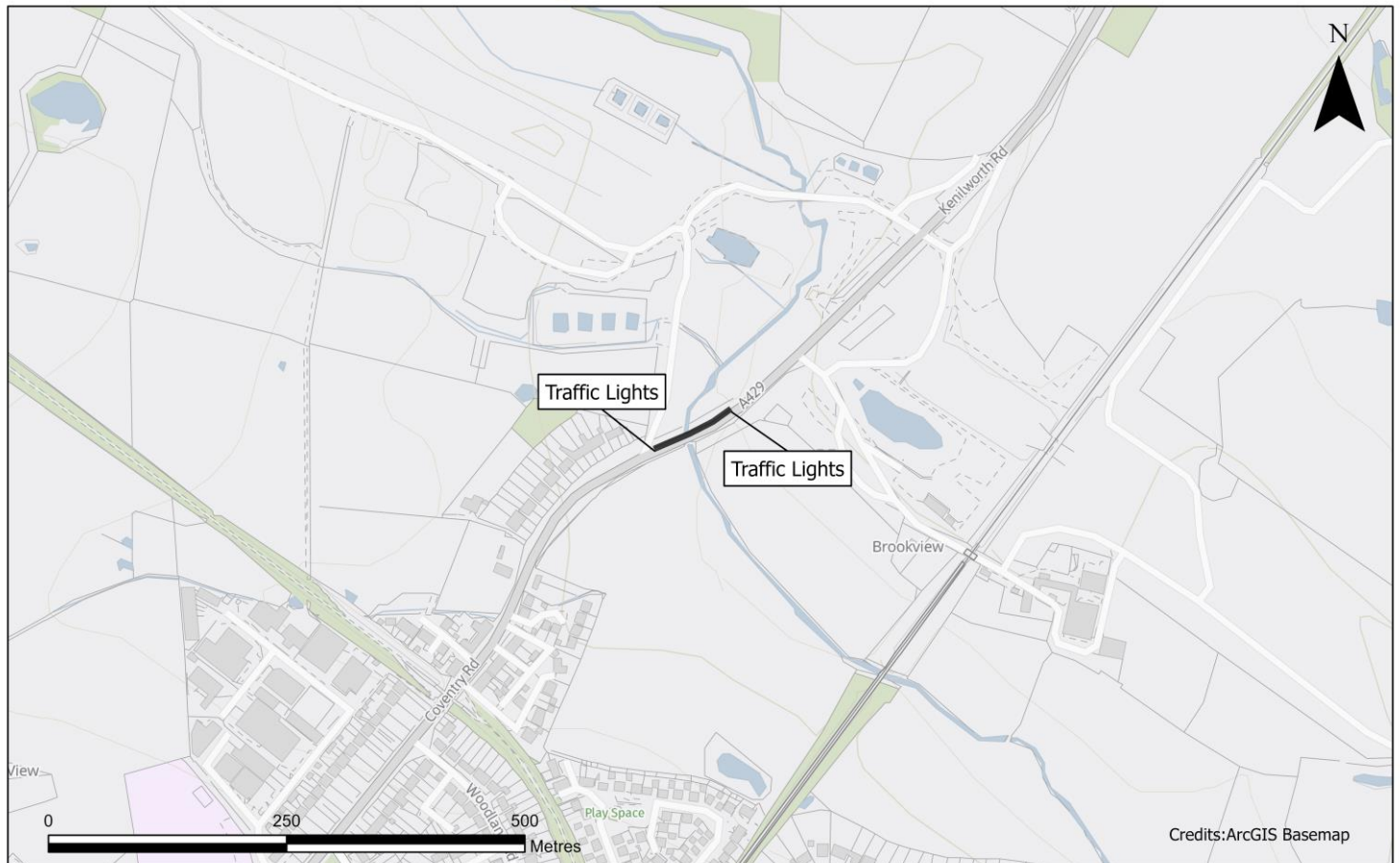
Our workforce may be on site one hour before and one hour after, to set up and secure our equipment
