



# Notice of overnight closures of the A452 northbound and A446 southbound

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

## The work we will be doing

A new high-speed railway station is being built within Solihull, near the M42, A45 Coventry Road and A446, close to the National Exhibition Centre and Birmingham Business Park.

To ensure the local road network is fit for purpose when the future HS2 interchange station is operational, we have been improving and expanding the existing road network.

As most of our improvements within the local area, are now complete, we will need to demolish a disused bridge structure over the A446.

Before doing so, we will need to undertake a series of preparatory works, so that the demolition can be carried out safely and efficiently.

To carry out these preparatory works, we will need to temporarily close the:

- A452 northbound each weeknight, 10pm to 6am, between Monday 20 January to Saturday 1 February 2025.
- A446 southbound each weeknight, 8pm to 6am, between Monday 20 January to Saturday 1 February 2025.

A452 northbound closures each weeknight, 10pm to 6am, between **Monday 20 January to Saturday 1 February 2025.**

A446 southbound closures each weeknight, from 8pm to 6am **Monday 20 January until Saturday 1 February.**




# A446 southbound diversion route
