# Notice of weekend road closures, Greatworth Temporary Road, Greatworth

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2innorthants.co.uk.

## What are we doing?

To support the construction of the Greatworth Green Tunnel we will be building a plant crossing area for our heavy construction vehicles to cross the Greatworth Temporary Road. This plant crossing will be controlled by traffic lights and be in place for the duration of the tunnel construction.

To build the crossing point we will be reinforcing the highway surface. This will require weekend road closures for up to three weekends, beginning on Friday 17 January 2025.

During the construction there will be traffic management on the Greatworth Temporary Road for approximately one month.

During this time there may be occasions when we will need to work across the road, traffic may be held at the lights for no more than 15 minutes to ensure a safe working area.

## When will these works take place?

**Traffic lights** from Tuesday 7 January to Friday 7 February 2025, 24 hours a day.

Completed weekend closures:

- 8pm Friday 17 January to 6am Monday 20 January 2025
- 8pm Friday 24 January to 6am Monday 27 January 2025

## Cancelled weekend closure

Friday 31 January to Monday 3 February 2025

#### New weekend closure

• 8pm Friday 7 February to 6am Monday 10 February 2025

## **Duration of works**

Greatworth Temporary Road will have:
Weekend road closures from 17 January 2025 to 10 February 2025.

Traffic lights from 7 January to 7 February 2025, 24 hours a day.

Once complete, there will be traffic lights at the plant crossing point on the Greatworth Temporary Road, until the completion of the Greatworth Green Tunnel.

## What to expect

Some nighttime working may be required.

Noise levels will be monitored.

## What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.


These works are subject to local authority consents and approvals.
