Works to build a cross passage near Eastcote Lane North, Northolt

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

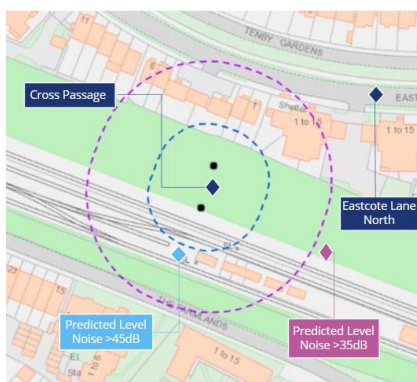
Cross passage construction

From **20 January to 9 February 2025**, we'll be building a cross passage near Eastcote Lane North, Northolt. We'll work 24 hours, seven days a week. During this time there will be periods of noisy works. To avoid overnight disturbance, we'll **limit noisy activities to between 7am and 10pm Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm on Saturday and 10 am to 3pm on Sunday** and carry out quieter works during the night.

Cross passages between the tunnels will allow HS2 passengers to get to a place of safety in an emergency. They are located and about 500 metres apart along the tunnels route.

Works to build cross passage involves breaking into the side of the completed tunnel, this might create some noise and vibration.

Properties that may be affected are shown within the purple and blue lines on the map below. These lines represent the predicted noise levels in these areas. This cross passage is about 23 metres below ground and 20 metres away from the closest property.
