



Road reinstatement works, Greenford

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What we are doing

From **20 to 27 January 2025** we will be carrying out road and footpath reinstatement works on Greenford Road and Bennetts Avenue, Greenford.

Phase one

From **20 to 23 January 2025**, we will replace the gas covers on Greenford Road and grout the kerb and footpath slabs. On Bennetts Avenue we will replace some asphalt on the footpath and repaint the yellow lines. This work will take place between 8am to 6pm.

There will be a narrowed lane and footpath along Greenford Road with traffic and pedestrian access maintained in both directions.

There will be a road closure on Bennetts Avenue at the junction with Greenford Road. For access to Bennetts Avenue from Greenford Road, traffic will be diverted towards Downing Drive and up Middleton Avenue.

Phase two

From **24 to 27 January 2025**, we will be carrying out footpath repair works on Greenford Road close to Rockware Avenue.

We will be using a vacuum excavator to dig up the footpath. Noise reducing barriers will be in place where possible to help minimise disruption.

There will be a lane and footpath closure with four-way temporary traffic lights during these works. A clearly signposted pedestrian diversion will be in place.

We will be working extended hours in agreement with Ealing Council:

- Friday 24 January, Saturday 25 January – 8am to 8pm
- Sunday 26 January - 8am to 6pm
- Monday 27 January - 8am to 8pm

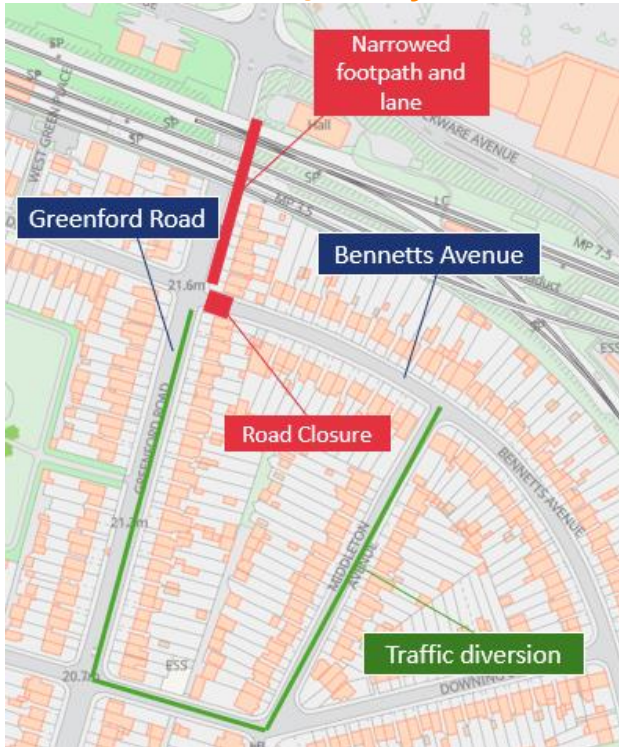

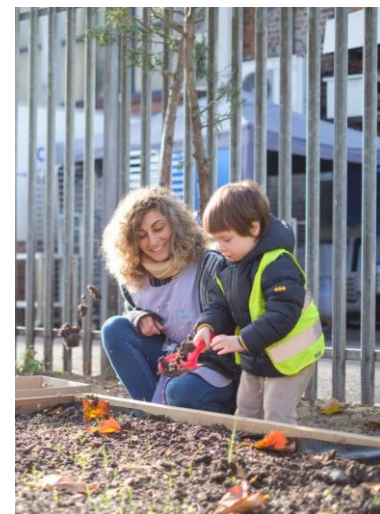
About our Community and Business Funds

We are offering two funds that are available to local communities and businesses between the West Midlands and London, to help with the disruption caused by our construction work. These are the Community and Environment Fund (CEF) and the Business and Local Economy Fund (BLEF).

The CEF is designed to give communities the opportunity to share in the benefits of HS2. It is an allocated fund that communities are able to apply for, to help to support local projects that aim to improve their local area.

The BLEF is designed to support local economies that may be disrupted by the construction of HS2. BLEF grants are for local business support organisations and local authorities to help maintain business activity in local communities.
