What are we doing?

In January 2025, we will be undertaking the four-day deck slide of the Small Dean Viaduct. The steel beams that are currently in place will be pushed into position, across the A413 London Road and the Chiltern Railway Line.

The first day of the viaduct launch will shift the beams closer to the road. As the deck will be pushed across the A413 on the following day, it will require a closure of the A413 to complete the viaduct push safely. The closure is in place to protect the safety of road users, and our team working on and close to the carriageway. For the third and fourth day, the Chiltern Railway line will be closed over the weekend for the deck to reach its final position.

An additional advance works notice will be issued for dates in February and March for overnight road closures and daytime lane closures to lower the viaduct deck onto its piers and complete bearing installations.

Emergency access will be maintained during the closure.

When will these works take place?

Full road closure of the A413:

Friday 31 January (5:30am) – Saturday 1 February (5:30am)

To minimise disruption, we will introduce a fully signposted diversion route.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but works will be completed in or around the set timeframes.

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.



Where will the closure be?


The map below shows the area for the road closure on 31 January 2025. During the closure period a fully signposted diversion route will be in operation.

To minimise congestion near the area of the viaduct launch area, both A413 Wendover Bypass (for southbound traffic) and A413 Missenden Bypass will be closed. In addition, Dunsmore Lane will be closed and London Road leading into Wendover.
