High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

## The work we will be doing

As part of the ongoing works to deliver the HS2 railway, we will be carrying out trial holes along the Fosse Way, B4455. To carry out these works safely, we will need to put in place 4-way temporary traffic lights on the Fosse Way.

## When will these works be taking place?

The temporary 4-way traffic lights will be in place on **Saturday 25 January 2025 between 7.00am to 2.00pm.**

## What to expect

You may notice construction activity along the public highway with minor travel disruptions to your journey.

Access to properties, pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained while the works are being carried out.


