

Notice of two overnight road closures of M42 northbound in February 2025

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

As we prepare for construction of the new M42 Coleshill Triple Box Bridge across the M42 motorway we will be carrying out overnight maintenance works, and validation of the current speed cameras placed along that section of motorway.

To allow us to complete these works, there will be overnight closures of the M42 northbound carriageway from junction 7 to junction 8. This will also include the slip road from M42 northbound at junction 7 to M6 southbound and the M6 Toll connector road northbound, from M6 junction 3a to M42 northbound.

When the work will take place

To ensure the safety of our workforce, we will be installing two overnight road closures on Friday 21 February and again overnight on Monday 24 February. The closures will be in place from 8pm each night and will be removed at 5am each morning.

This work is subject to consent with National Highways.

Where will the work take place



Map of closure and diversion route

This map shows where the road closures will be in place on the M42.

A road closure of the M42 northbound carriageway from J7 to J8 as well as the slip road from M42 northbound at J7 to M6 southbound and the M6Toll northbound connector road from M6 northbound at J3a to M42 northbound at J7a.

A diversion route will be in place from M6 northbound to J5. At M6 J5 traffic should leave and rejoin the M6 southbound to M6 J4a, eastbound link road to rejoin the M42 where the diversion ends.
