What are we doing?

We are approaching the next phase of our construction at Rocky Lane. So far, our works in this area have been constructed offline. Rocky Lane is set to be diverted under the new underbridge, which will take the road under the railway.

In conjunction with the underbridge construction, from February 2025 we will be progressing with highway works and completing a realignment of the road. To construct the realignment, Rocky Lane will be closed for six months. We will be undertaking multiple activities including earthworks, drainage, utility diversions, and full road construction.

The purpose of the realignment will be to allow the HS2 train to pass over the road. Traffic and road users will be diverted via the underbridge which is under construction.

We will need to close the road due to the width of the carriageway being insufficient to complete the work under lane closures. Operating under lane closures would not be safe for the public or our workforce. A full road closure allows the various works to be undertaken along the full length of the closed road.

When will these works take place?

- **Monday 17 February – Monday 18 August 2025**

To minimise disruption, we will introduce a fully signposted diversion route, please refer to the map on the following page.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but works will be completed in or around the set timeframes.

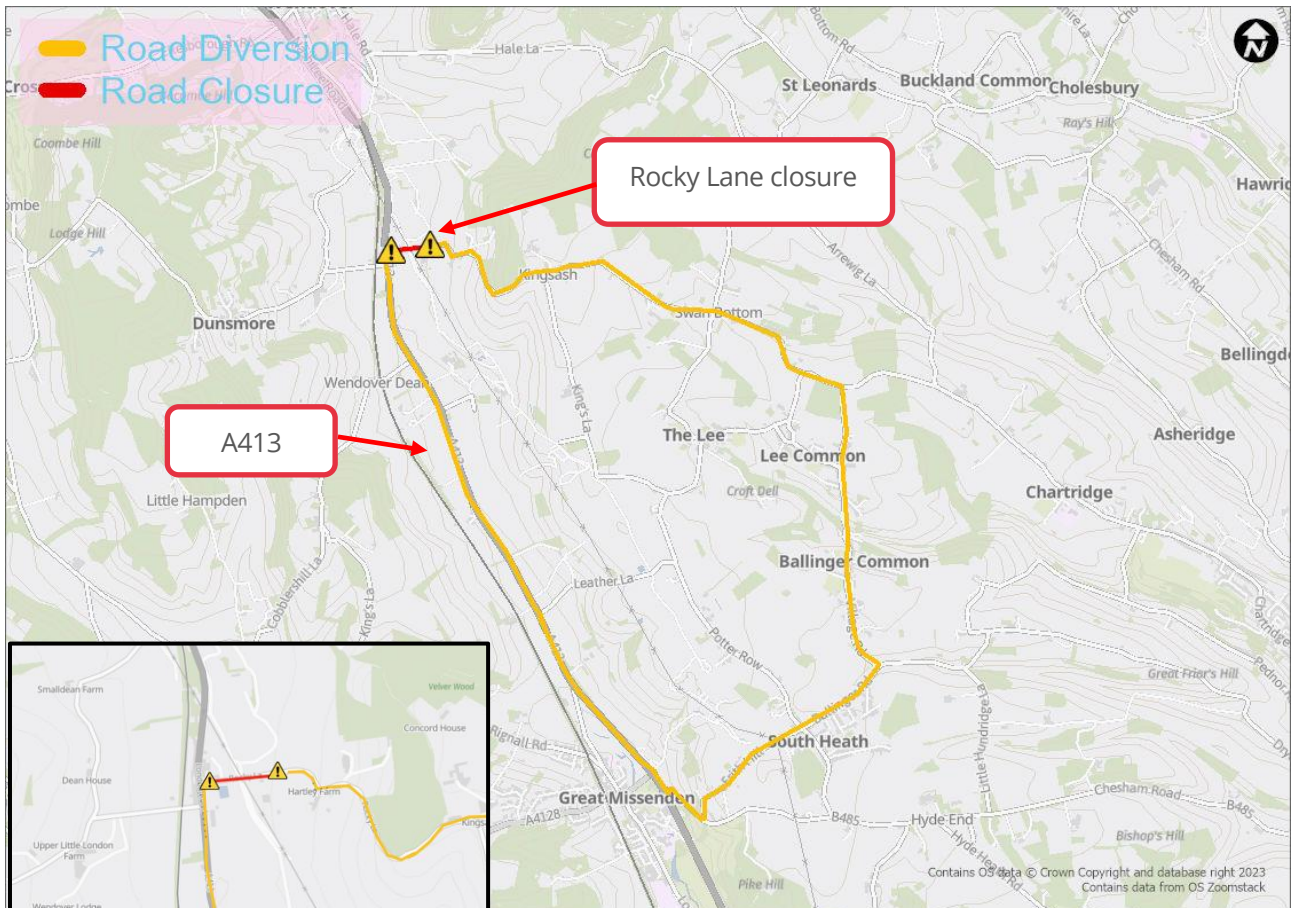

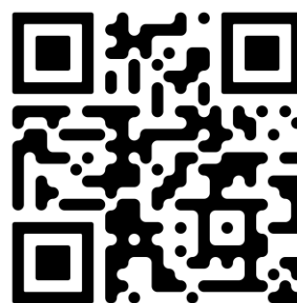


Rocky Lane construction video

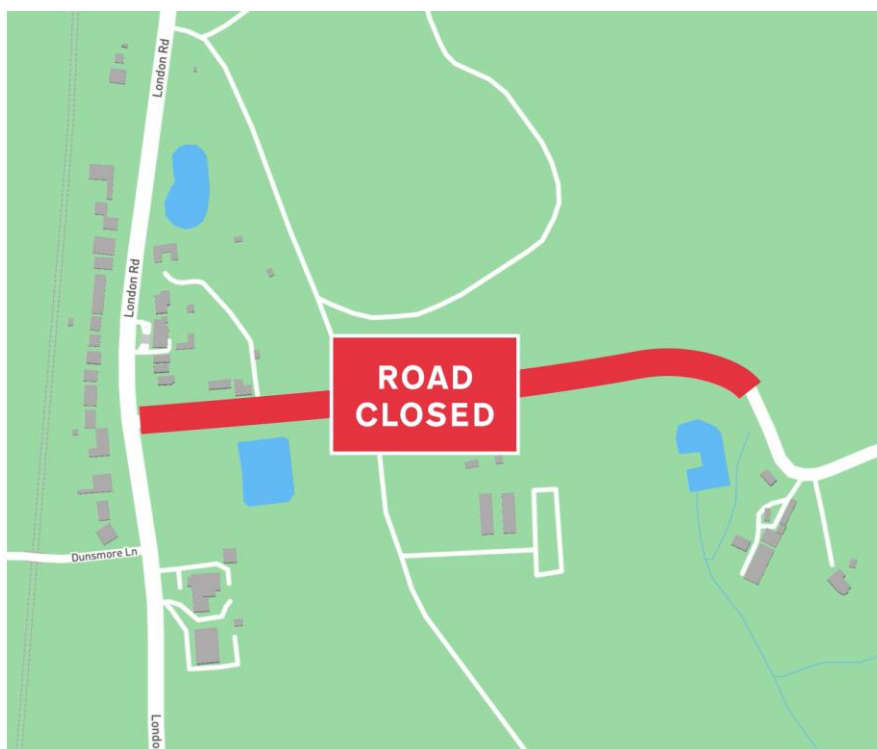
Rocky Lane road closure

As part of our preparation works for the construction of an underbridge, we need to close **Rocky Lane** to divert the road underneath the new structure.

The closure will be in place from:

**Monday 17 February to
Monday 18 August 2025**

For the duration of the closure, we will be undertaking multiple activities including earthworks, drainage, utility diversions and full road construction.
