High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We are continuing works on Rugby Road to complete the final stages of the bridge construction and progress the permanent road realignment works. To do these works safely we will install a temporary closure of Rugby Road. This is ahead of future closures for utility diversions during the Spring.

When will these works be taking place

The work will be carried out on **Saturday 22 March 2025, between 8am to 1pm.**

What to expect

Rugby Road will be closed and a signed diversion route will be in place (see map on page two). You may notice some minor disruption to travel times. Please plan your journey ahead of time.

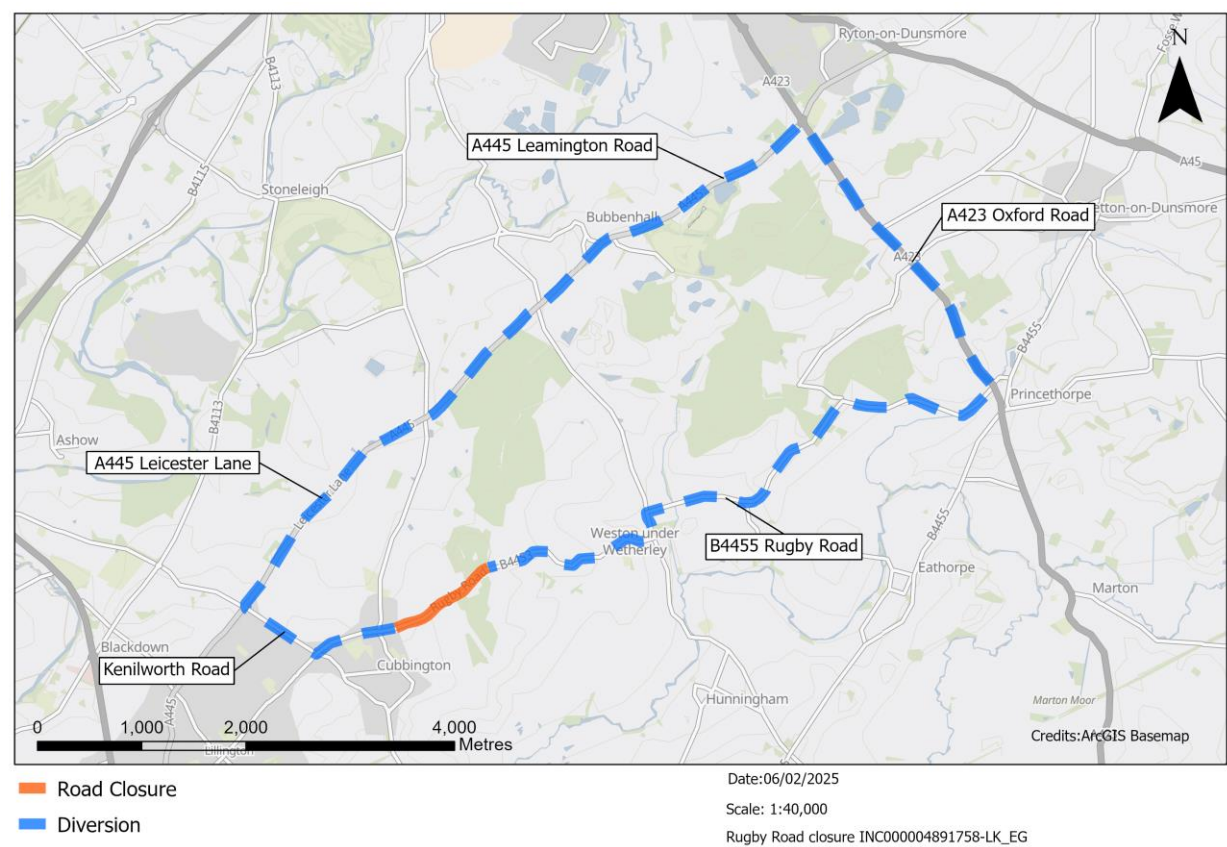
The diversion route

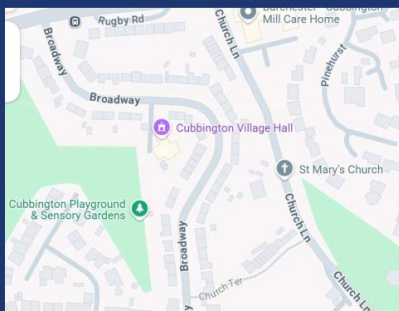
