High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. If you have any questions about these works, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2innorthants.co.uk.

What are we doing?

As part of our preparatory works and for the safety of the public, we have previously closed some Public Rights of Way (PRoWs) in the Calvert area.

We are now able to reopen a section of GUN/28/1 each Sunday ongoing from 2 March 2025 as follows;

- 2 March to 30 November 8.00am until 7.00pm.
- 1 December to 28 February 8.00am to 4.00pm.

When approaching GUN/28/1 from Grendon Underwood, there will be security staff positioned where the PRoW meets our works, either end of our site. Security will use the designated coned 3m walkway to safely guide any pedestrian or equestrian across the construction area and onto the newly opened section of GUN/28/1 which links to other local bridleways.

Please note that other than Sundays on the specified hours above, this bridleway will remain closed at all other times.

When will these works take place?

This reopening of PRoW GUN/28/1 will re-open on Sunday's only from 2 March 2025. Repair works to GUN/28 will continue.

A section of GUN/28/1 will be opened each Sunday from 2 March 2025:

- 2 March to 30 November 8.00am until 7.00pm.
- 1 December to 28 February 8.00am to 4.00pm.

Security led access along GUN/28/1 through our work site.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

Install and maintain local signs to inform people of temporary closures and diversions.

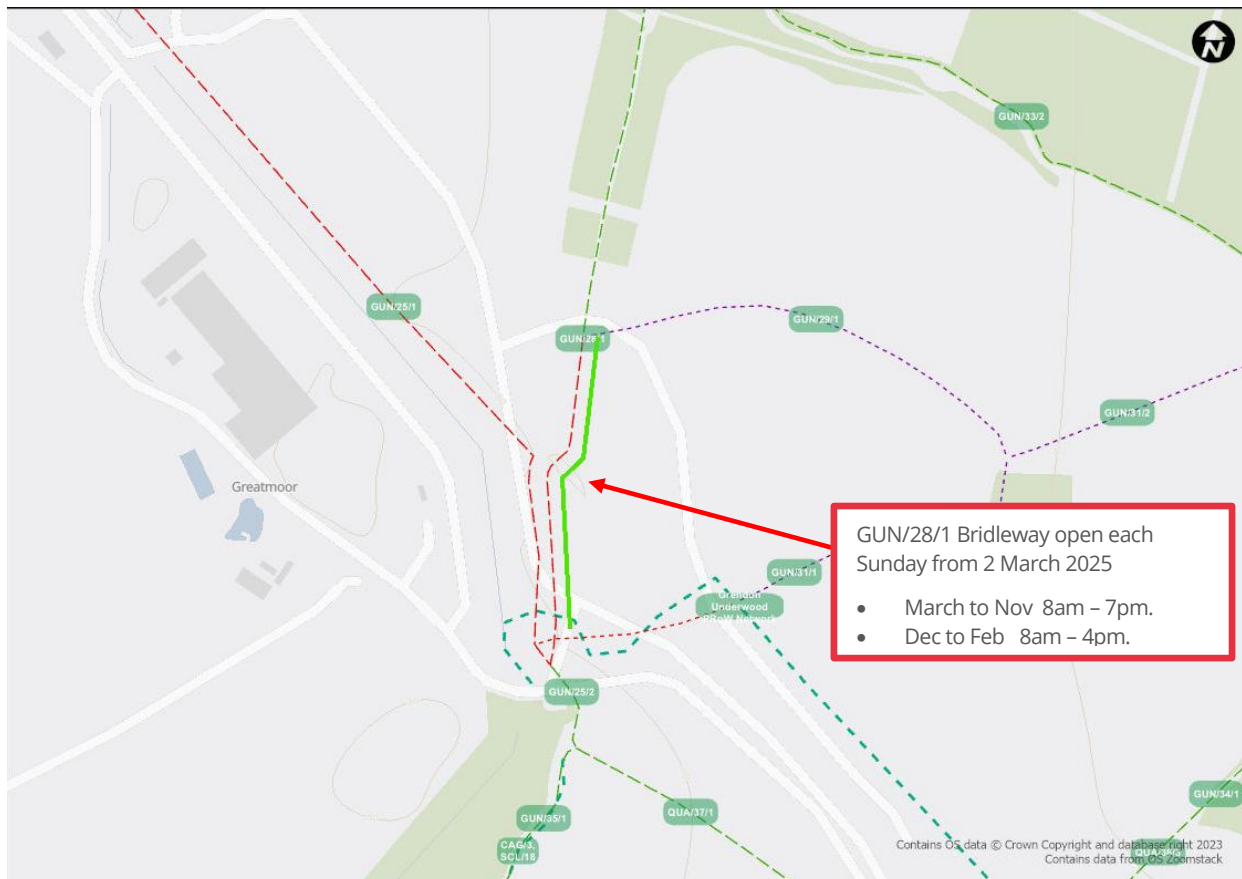
