### What are we doing?

In early March 2025 we will be closing a section of Shipton Lee Road to carry out tree surveys and general verge works.

Our team will be working to complete these works in two days.

To carry out these works safely and effectively we will need to put in place a road closure with signed diversions. Our teams will be working in open trenches on and around carriageway.

### When will these works take place?

A section of Shipton Lee Road will be closed during the day from 8.30am to 5.30pm, from Wednesday 5 March until Thursday 6 March 2025.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes or updates.

### Duration of works

A section of Shipton Lee Road will be closed 8.30am to 5.30pm Wednesday 5 March to Thursday 6 March 2025.

These works will be carried out within our normal working hours.

Full road closure of a section of Shipton Lee Road for two days.

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

### What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Provide a full diversion route for road users.

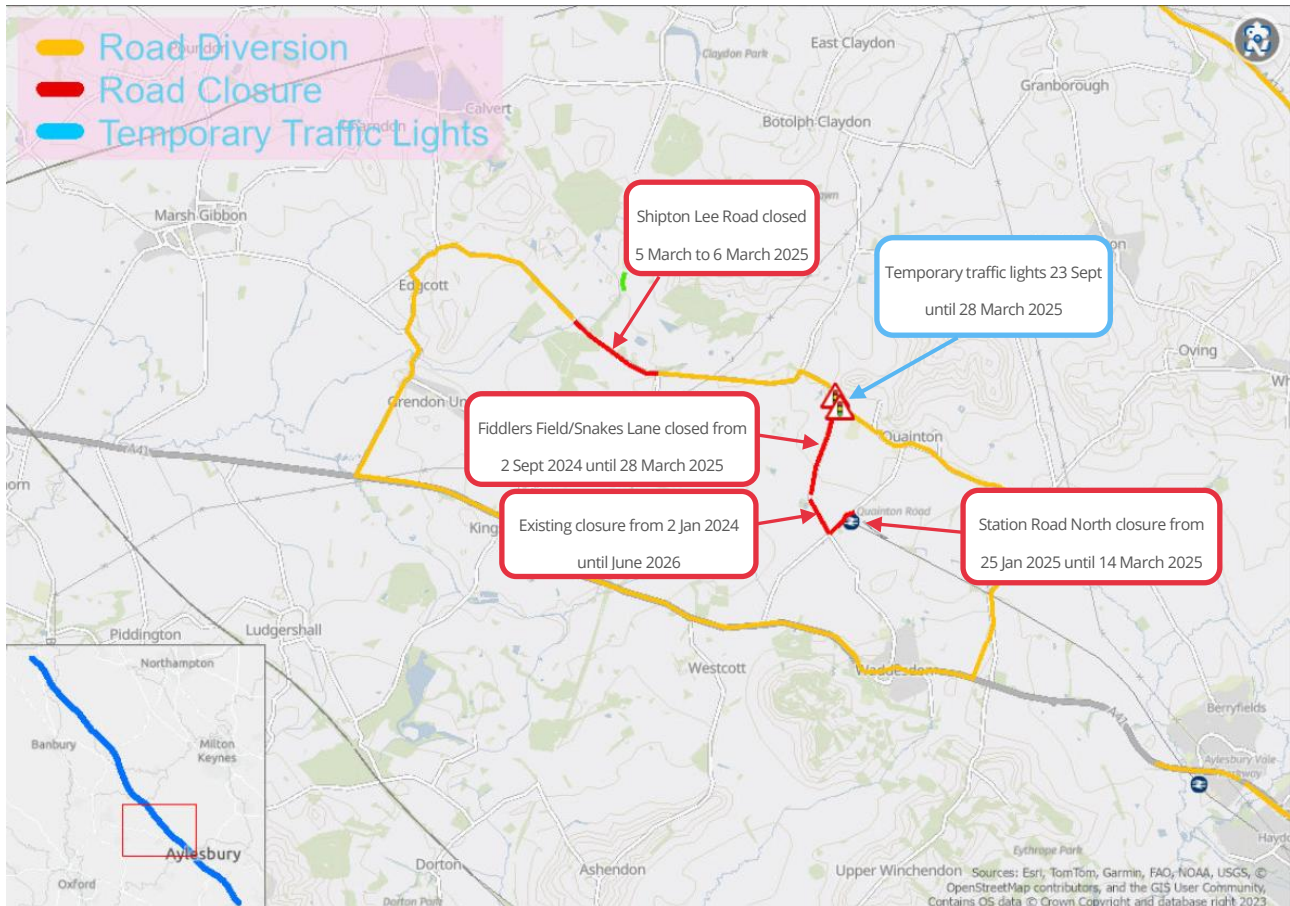
