



Notice of full weekend road closures, A43, Brackley

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2innorthants.co.uk.

What are we doing?

In the spring, we begin installing the steel beams for the permanent A43 overbridge deck. The installation involves lifting 7 pairs of connected beams. Each pair weighs 137 tonnes and is 65m long. We are lifting them from the A43 northbound road onto the central construction area, which is in the middle of the A43.

We need to make sure safety comes first. This means we will have to temporarily close a section of the A43 in both directions, between Brackley North and the B4525 junction. There will be no access from Radstone village on to the A43.

When will these works take place?

A section of the A43 will be fully closed in both directions, **northbound** and **southbound** between Brackley North (Northampton Road) and the B4525 junction, from:

- **10pm Friday 14 March to 8pm Sunday 16 March**

Due to National Highways Essential Maintenance Works (A43 Brook Culvert Geotechnical Scheme), residents will not be able to exit Whitfield and travel north onto the A43. This collaborative effort aims to minimise future closures on the A43.

Whitfield residents will be allowed to use the permits from last weekend's closure, for the vehicle escort service.

As a contingency, should there be delays to our works, due to circumstances outside of our control such as weather, a further full weekend closure will take place on:

- 10pm Friday 21 March to 6am Monday 24 March

These works are subject to consents.

Duration of works

A section of the **A43 in both directions Northbound & Southbound** between Brackley North and the B4525 junction will be closed:

10pm Friday 14 March to
8pm Sunday 16 March

What to expect

Full weekend closures of the A43 in late February and early March to lift and install the steel bridge beams.

We would remind all road users to plan their journeys, allow more time and follow the signed diversion routes.

What we will do

Access for blue light services will be under escort along the A43 southbound carriageway.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

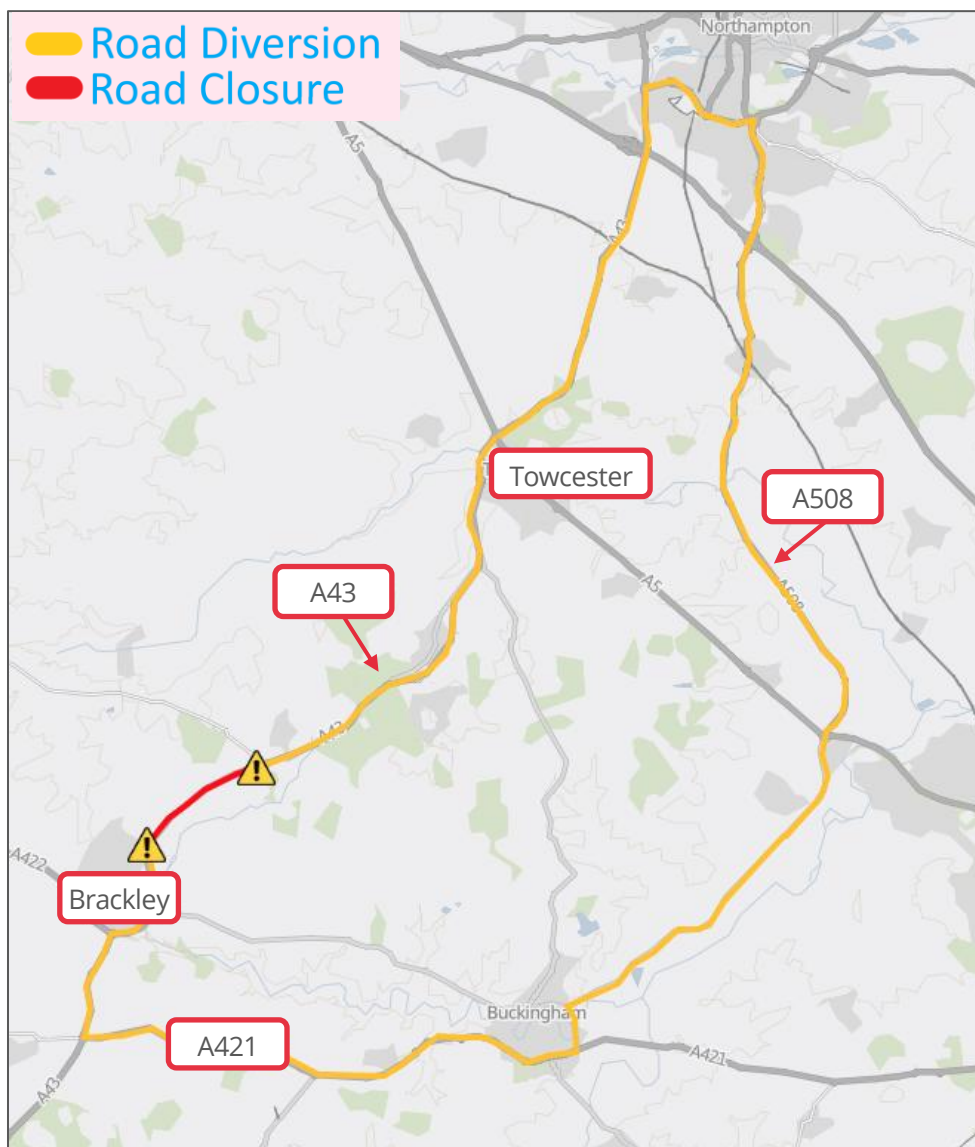
Where will the works take place?

The map below, shows the approximate closure area on the A43, between Brackley and Whitfield. We understand there may be shorter diversions, but we are obligated to share a diversion with like for like roads.

For road users wishing to travel north use the alternative routes A421, A422 and the A508.

For road users wishing to travel south use the alternative routes A508, A422 and the A421.

In addition to this notice, the road closure information will also be communicated through traditional road signage as well as electronic signage. These signs will be located in strategic locations and placed in a safe location.



Notice of full weekend road closures, A43, Brackley

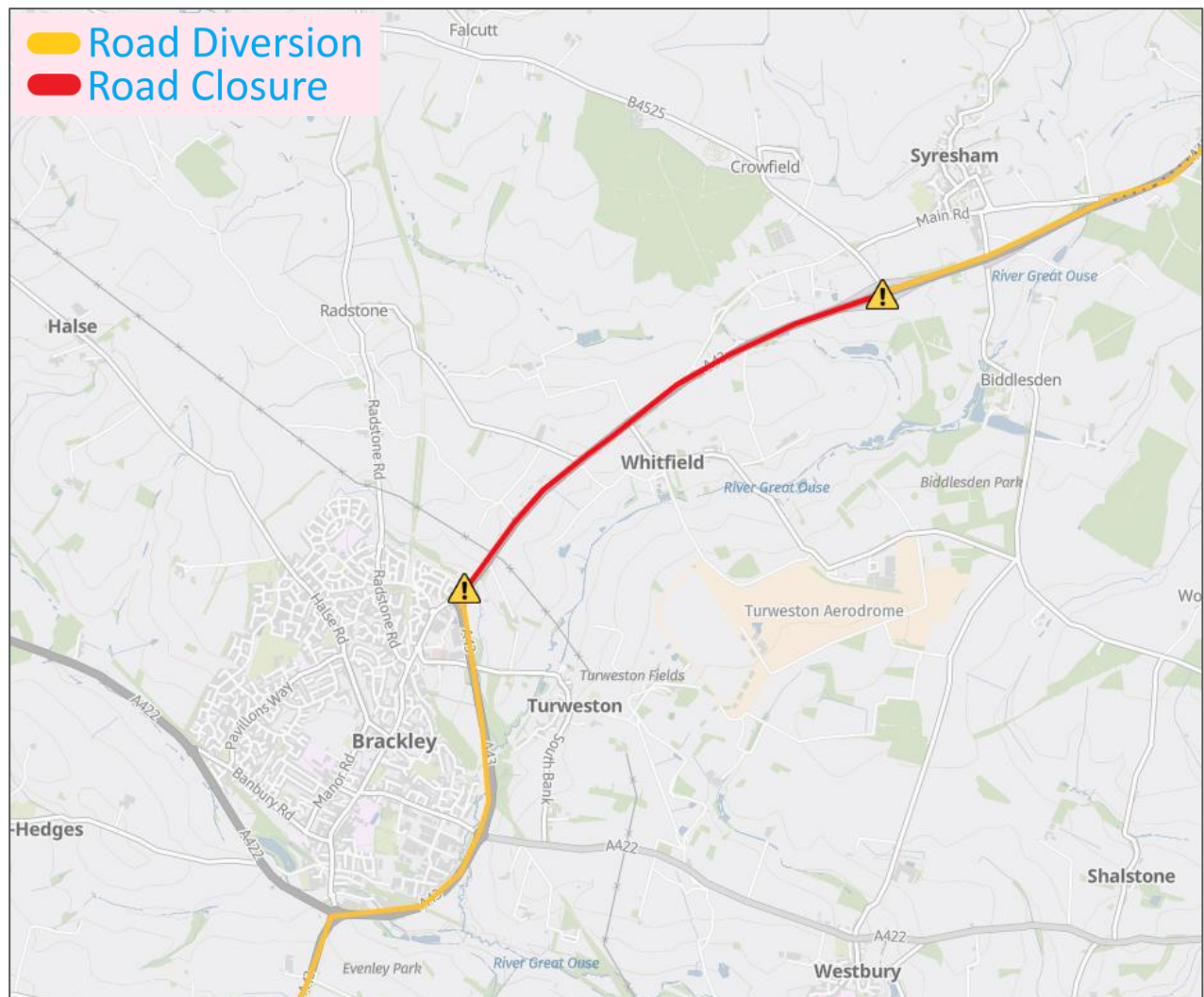
